## INTRODUCTION

---

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper use and care of your Orient Men's 2nd Gen. Bambino Ver. 2 Japanese Automatic Stainless Steel and Leather Dress Watch. Featuring a classic white dial with elegant blue hands and a domed mineral crystal, this timepiece combines traditional aesthetics with reliable automatic movement. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

## SETUP

1. **Unboxing and Inspection:** Carefully remove your watch from its packaging. Inspect the watch for any visible damage or imperfections. The watch comes securely packaged in a branded box.

- 2. Adjusting the Strap:** The watch features a brown leather strap with a buckle clasp. Adjust the strap to achieve a comfortable and secure fit on your wrist. Ensure it is not too tight to restrict circulation, nor too loose to move freely.

3. **Initial Winding:** As an automatic watch, it is powered by the motion of your wrist. For initial use or after a period of inactivity, manually wind the watch. To do this, ensure the crown is pushed in completely, then rotate it clockwise approximately 30-40 times. This action builds up the initial power reserve.
4. **Setting Time and Date:**
  - **Setting the Date:** Pull the crown out to the **first click**. Rotate the crown to adjust the date.
  - **Setting the Time:** Pull the crown out to the **second click**. The second hand will stop (hacking feature), allowing for precise time setting. Rotate the crown to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time. Push the crown back in completely to start the watch.

## OPERATING YOUR WATCH

- **Automatic Movement:** Your Orient Bambino watch is equipped with a Japanese Automatic movement (Caliber F6722). This movement is self-winding, meaning it gains power from the natural motion of your arm while wearing the watch. When worn regularly, it will maintain its power reserve without the need for manual winding.
- **Hand-Winding Capability:** If the watch has stopped due to lack of wear, it can be manually wound by rotating the crown clockwise while it is in the fully pushed-in position. This provides a quick power boost to get the watch running.
- **Hacking Feature:** The F6722 movement includes a hacking function. When the crown is pulled out to the time-setting position (second click), the second hand will stop, allowing you to set the time with precision.
- **Water Resistance:** This watch is rated as water resistant to 30 meters (100 feet). This means it is suitable for everyday use and can withstand splashes or brief immersion in water. However, it is **not recommended** for swimming, diving, or showering, as prolonged exposure to water pressure or steam can compromise its seals.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Watch:** Regularly wipe the watch case, crystal, and strap with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to remove dust, sweat, and fingerprints. For stubborn dirt on the case, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- **Leather Strap Care:** Avoid prolonged exposure of the leather strap to water, direct sunlight, and extreme temperatures, as these can cause drying, cracking, or discoloration. If the strap gets wet, gently pat it dry and allow it to air dry completely away from direct heat.
- **Avoiding Magnetic Fields:** Keep your watch away from strong magnetic fields (e.g., speakers, refrigerators, mobile phones, tablets, magnetic clasps) as magnetism can affect the accuracy of the automatic movement.

- **Storage:** When not wearing your watch, store it in a cool, dry place. The original watch box provides excellent protection. If storing for an extended period, consider a watch winder to keep the automatic movement running and lubricated.
- **Professional Servicing:** For optimal performance and longevity, it is recommended to have your automatic watch serviced by a qualified watchmaker every 3 to 5 years. This includes cleaning, lubrication, and checking the movement's accuracy and water resistance seals.


## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:**
  - Ensure the watch has sufficient power reserve. Manually wind it by rotating the crown clockwise 30-40 times.
  - If the watch still does not run after manual winding and wearing, it may require professional inspection.
- **Inaccurate Time:**
  - Automatic watches may exhibit slight variations in accuracy. If the deviation is significant, ensure the watch is fully wound.
  - Avoid exposing the watch to strong magnetic fields, which can magnetize the movement and affect accuracy.
  - If accuracy issues persist, professional adjustment by a watchmaker may be needed.
- **Date Not Changing:**
  - Ensure the time is set correctly, especially past midnight for the date change mechanism to engage.
  - Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can interfere with the date change mechanism and potentially damage it.
