## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your NuWave 20356 Pro Digital Controlled Infrared Tabletop Oven. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or the appliance housing in water or other liquids.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Do not operate the oven if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- Keep children and pets away from the appliance during operation.
- Allow the oven to cool completely before cleaning or storing.
- This appliance is not microwaveable.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present upon unpacking:

- NuWave 20356 Pro Digital Controlled Infrared Tabletop Oven Unit
- Sheet Pan
- User Manual (this document)

## SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials from the oven.

- Placement:** Place the oven on a flat, stable, heat-resistant surface, ensuring adequate ventilation around the unit. Maintain at least 6 inches of clearance from walls and other appliances.
- Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe down the interior and exterior surfaces with a damp cloth. Wash the sheet pan with warm, soapy water and dry thoroughly.
- Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Basic Operation

- Prepare Food:** Place food directly on the cooking rack or in an appropriate oven-safe dish.
- Load Oven:** Carefully place the food into the oven. Ensure the dome is securely seated on the base.
- Set Temperature:** Use the digital controls on the lid to set the desired cooking temperature. Refer to recipes or cooking guides for recommended temperatures.
- Set Time:** Use the digital controls to set the cooking duration.
- Start Cooking:** Press the "Start" button to begin the cooking cycle. The infrared heating element will activate.
- Monitoring:** The clear dome allows for visual monitoring of the cooking process.
- Completion:** The oven will automatically shut off when the set time expires. A chime may sound.
- Remove Food:** Use oven mitts to carefully remove cooked food from the oven. The interior and exterior surfaces will be hot.

### Digital Controls

The digital control panel on the lid allows for precise temperature and time adjustments. Buttons typically include:

- **TEMP +/-:** Adjusts cooking temperature.
- **TIME +/-:** Adjusts cooking duration.

- **START/PAUSE:** Initiates or temporarily stops the cooking cycle.
- **CANCEL:** Stops the current cooking cycle and resets settings.

## MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your NuWave oven.

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the oven from the power outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
3. **Interior Cleaning:** The clear dome and cooking racks can be hand washed with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
4. **Base Unit:** The base unit, containing electrical components, should never be immersed in water. Wipe with a damp cloth only.
5. **Sheet Pan:** The included sheet pan is hand wash only.
6. **Storage:** Store the oven in a clean, dry place when not in use.

**Important:** This appliance is not dishwasher safe. Hand wash only.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage; faulty outlet.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Check circuit breaker. Test outlet with another appliance.
Food not cooking evenly.	Improper food placement; incorrect temperature/time settings.	Ensure food is centered and not overcrowding the oven. Adjust temperature and time as needed.
Smoke or unusual odor during operation.	Food residue; new appliance odor.	Unplug immediately. Allow to cool and clean thoroughly. A slight odor on first use is normal. If smoke persists, discontinue use and contact support.
Digital display not working.	Power issue; internal malfunction.	Unplug the unit for 5 minutes, then plug back in. If issue persists, contact customer support.




