1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the world of Super Smash Bros. Ultimate! This manual provides essential information for setting up, playing, and maintaining your game. Super Smash Bros. Ultimate brings together gaming icons in an ultimate brawl, playable anytime, anywhere on your Nintendo Switch console.

2. KEY FEATURES

3. SETUP

3.1. Inserting the Game Card

1. Ensure your Nintendo Switch console is powered off or in sleep mode.
2. Locate the game card slot on your Nintendo Switch console.
3. Insert the Super Smash Bros. Ultimate game card into the slot with the label facing the same direction as the console screen. Push until it clicks into place.
4. Power on your Nintendo Switch. The game icon should appear on the HOME Menu.

3.2. Initial Game Launch

Select the Super Smash Bros. Ultimate icon from the HOME Menu to start the game. Follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup, including language selection and user profile association. Ensure your console has sufficient storage space for game updates.

4. OPERATING THE GAME

4.1. Basic Controls

Controls may vary slightly depending on the controller type (Joy-Con, Pro Controller, GameCube Controller). The game provides an in-game tutorial for specific character moves and advanced techniques.

- **Movement:** Left Stick
- **Jump:** X or Y Button
- **Standard Attack:** A Button
- **Special Attack:** B Button
- **Grab:** L or R Button + A Button (or ZL/ZR)
- **Shield:** L or R Button (or ZL/ZR)
- **Smash Attack:** Flick Left Stick + A Button

4.2. Game Modes

Super Smash Bros. Ultimate offers a variety of modes to suit different play styles:

- **Smash:** Standard battles, customizable with rules, items, and stages. Supports 1-8 players locally or online.

- **Adventure Mode: World of Light:** A single-player campaign where you rescue fighters and spirits.
- **Classic Mode:** A series of battles culminating in a boss fight, unique to each character.
- **Training:** Practice moves and combos against a stationary opponent.
- **Spirit Board:** Challenge various Spirit teams to earn new Spirits.
- **Online Play:** Compete against players worldwide in various match types. A Nintendo Switch Online membership is required for online features.

5. GAMEPLAY TIPS

- **Understand Percentages:** The higher a fighter's percentage, the farther they will fly when hit. Focus on increasing opponents' percentages before attempting to launch them off the stage.
- **Master Recovery:** Learn your character's recovery moves (up-special, air dodges, multiple jumps) to return to the stage after being launched.
- **Utilize Items:** Items can turn the tide of battle. Learn what each item does and when to use it effectively.
- **Experiment with Characters:** With over 70 fighters, try different characters to find one that suits your play style. Each character has unique strengths and weaknesses.
- **Stage Awareness:** Familiarize yourself with different stages. Some stages have hazards or unique layouts that can be used to your advantage or disadvantage.

- Verify your Nintendo Switch is connected to a stable internet connection.
- Ensure your Nintendo Switch Online membership is active.
- Restart your router and modem.
- Check Nintendo's official website for any network maintenance or service outages.

8.3. Controller Not Responding

- Ensure your Joy-Cons or Pro Controller are properly paired with the console.
- Check the battery level of your controllers.
- Try detaching and reattaching Joy-Cons, or re-pairing Bluetooth controllers.
