# Nakamichi NA1001 10.1-inch WVGA 1-DIN Multimedia AV Receiver User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Nakamichi NA1001 10.1-inch WVGA 1-DIN Multimedia AV Receiver. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper operation and to prevent damage.

The Nakamichi NA1001 is a versatile multimedia receiver featuring a 10.1-inch WVGA touchscreen display, built-in 50W x 4 amplifier, Bluetooth for hands-free calling, and Mirror Link functionality. It is designed to enhance your in-car entertainment and connectivity experience.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not operate the unit in a manner that distracts you from driving. Always observe traffic laws and regulations.
- Ensure all wiring is correctly connected to prevent short circuits or damage to the vehicle's electrical system.
- Consult a qualified professional for installation if you are unsure about any steps. Incorrect installation can lead to malfunction or damage.
- Do not disassemble or modify the unit. This may cause accidents, fire, or electric shock.
- Keep the volume at a level that allows you to hear outside sounds, such as emergency vehicles.

## SETUP

### 1. Installation

The Nakamichi NA1001 is a 1-DIN unit with a 10.1-inch display. Professional installation is recommended due to the complexity of vehicle wiring and dashboard integration.

#### General Installation Steps:

1. Disconnect the vehicle's negative battery terminal before starting any electrical work.

2. Remove the existing car stereo unit from the dashboard.
3. Mount the NA1001 chassis into the 1-DIN opening.
4. Connect the wiring harness as described in the wiring diagram.
5. Secure the display panel.
6. Reconnect the vehicle's negative battery terminal.
7. Test the unit's functionality before fully reassembling the dashboard.

## 2. Wiring Connections

Refer to the detailed wiring diagram provided with your unit for specific connections. Key connections include:

- **Power Wires:** Constant 12V (Yellow), Accessory 12V (Red), Ground (Black).
- **Speaker Wires:** Connect to your vehicle's speakers (Front Left, Front Right, Rear Left, Rear Right).
- **Antenna:** Connect the vehicle's radio antenna.
- **USB Port:** For media playback and Mirror Link.
- **Steering Wheel Control (SWC):** Connect to your vehicle's SWC interface (if applicable).
- **Reverse Camera Input:** For connecting an optional reverse camera.

### 3. Initial Power On

After installation, turn on your vehicle's ignition. The unit should power on automatically. Follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup, such as language selection or time zone settings.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Basic Controls

- **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the power button (usually on the front panel) to turn the unit on or off. A short press may mute/unmute.
- **Volume Control:** Use the volume knob or on-screen controls to adjust the audio level.
- **Touchscreen Interface:** Navigate through menus and select functions by touching the icons on the 10.1-inch WVGA display.

## 2. Audio Playback

- **USB Playback:** Insert a USB drive into the designated USB port. The unit will automatically detect and display playable media files (audio, video, images). Use the on-screen controls to browse and select files.
- **Bluetooth Audio Streaming:** After pairing your device (see Bluetooth Pairing), select the Bluetooth Audio source. You can then play music from your paired smartphone or other Bluetooth-enabled device.

## 3. Bluetooth Pairing (Hands-free Calling)

1. On the NA1001, navigate to the Bluetooth menu.
2. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your mobile device and set to "discoverable" mode.
3. On the NA1001 screen, search for available devices. Select your device from the list.
4. Confirm the pairing code on both the receiver and your mobile device.
5. Once paired, you can make and receive calls directly through the receiver and stream audio.

## 4. Mirror Link Function

The Mirror Link feature allows you to display your smartphone's screen on the NA1001's display. This typically

requires a USB connection and a specific application on your smartphone.

1. Connect your smartphone to the NA1001 via a USB cable.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions on the NA1001 and your smartphone to establish the Mirror Link connection. This may involve installing a companion app on your phone.
3. Once connected, your phone's screen will be mirrored on the receiver's display, allowing for control of compatible apps.

## 5. Radio Tuner

Select the "Radio" source from the main menu. You can scan for stations, save presets, and switch between AM/FM bands using the on-screen controls.

## 6. Steering Wheel Control (SWC)

If your vehicle supports SWC and it has been correctly wired, you can configure the NA1001 to respond to your steering wheel buttons. Access the SWC settings menu on the receiver to program the functions (e.g., volume up/down, track skip, mode change).

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the touchscreen. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check the Nakamichi website for any available firmware updates for your NA1001 model. Updates can improve performance and add new features. Follow the instructions provided with the update package carefully.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Incorrect wiring; Blown fuse; Vehicle battery issue.	Check power connections (Yellow, Red, Black wires). Inspect the unit's fuse and vehicle's fuse box. Ensure battery is charged.
No sound	Volume too low; Mute activated; Incorrect speaker wiring; Source not selected.	Increase volume. Check if mute is active. Verify speaker connections. Select the correct audio source.
Bluetooth not connecting	Bluetooth not enabled on device; Device not in pairing mode; Interference.	Ensure Bluetooth is on and discoverable on your phone. Try re-pairing. Move closer to the unit.
Touchscreen unresponsive	Temporary software glitch; Unit frozen.	Perform a soft reset (locate the reset button, usually a small pinhole). If issue persists, disconnect battery for a few minutes.
Mirror Link not working	Incorrect USB cable; App not installed; Phone compatibility.	Use a high-quality USB data cable. Ensure the required Mirror Link app is installed on your phone. Check phone compatibility with the NA1001.
