Your bond with Eevee will grow stronger as you care for it and travel together. Customize both Eevee and your Trainer with various outfits to explore the world in style. Catch wild Pokémon using intuitive motion controls and connect with the Pokémon GO app to enhance your adventure.

## 2. SETUP

---

1. **Insert Game Card:** Carefully insert the Pokémon: Let's Go, Eevee! game card into the Nintendo Switch console's game card slot. Ensure it clicks into place.
2. **Launch Game:** From the Nintendo Switch HOME Menu, select the Pokémon: Let's Go, Eevee! icon to start the game.
3. **Initial Setup:** Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, create your Trainer, and begin your adventure.
4. **Controller Options:** The game supports various control methods:
  - **Joy-Con Controllers:** Use a single Joy-Con controller for motion-based catching mechanics.
  - **Poké Ball Plus:** Enhance your experience with the Poké Ball Plus accessory (sold separately), which provides immersive light, vibration, and sound feedback.
  - **Handheld Mode:** Utilize traditional button controls when playing in handheld mode.

## 3. OPERATING THE GAME

---

### 3.1 Becoming a Pokémon Trainer

Your primary goal is to become the best Pokémon Trainer by collecting Pokémon, battling other trainers, and challenging Gym Leaders across the Kanto region.

### 3.2 Catching Wild Pokémon

Unlike traditional Pokémon games, wild Pokémon appear directly on the overworld map. To catch them:

1. Approach a wild Pokémon to initiate an encounter.
2. Use a gentle throwing motion with your Joy-Con controller or Poké Ball Plus to throw a Poké Ball at the Pokémon. Timing and accuracy are key.
3. Successful catches award experience points to your entire party.

### 3.3 Battling Trainers

Engage in turn-based battles against other Pokémon Trainers and powerful Gym Leaders. Strategize your Pokémon's moves and types to overcome opponents.

### 3.4 Your Partner Pokémon (Eevee)

Eevee is your constant companion throughout the journey. It can learn special techniques and assist you in various ways. You can also customize Eevee's appearance with different outfits.

### 3.5 Connecting with Pokémon GO

Transfer Pokémon originally discovered in the Kanto region from your Pokémon GO app to Pokémon: Let's Go, Eevee! This includes Alolan and Shiny forms, as well as the newly discovered Pokémon, Meltan. A compatible smartphone with the Pokémon GO app and persistent internet access are required.

### 3.6 Multiplayer

Share your adventure with family or friends using a second Joy-Con or Poké Ball Plus (sold separately). Local wireless and online play options are available for battling and trading Pokémons. A Nintendo Switch Online membership and Nintendo Account are required for online features.

## 4. KEY FEATURES

---

- Embark on a Pokémons Trainer journey through the Kanto region.
- Encounter and catch Pokémons in the wild using a gentle throwing motion with a Joy-Con controller or Poké Ball Plus accessory, which provides light, vibration, and sound feedback.
- Customize your partner Eevee and your Trainer with a selection of outfits.
- Connect to the Pokémons GO app to transfer Kanto-region Pokémons, including Alolan and Shiny forms, and the newly discovered Pokémons, Melton.
- Engage in battles with other Trainers and Gym Leaders, and trade Pokémons with other players via local wireless or online.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

- **General Performance:** If the game experiences slowdowns or crashes, try restarting the game or the Nintendo Switch console. Ensure sufficient storage space is available.


