# **Magic Chef Compact Electric Laundry Dryer User Manual**

## **1. INTRODUCTION**

Thank you for choosing the Magic Chef 1.5 cu. ft. Compact Electric Laundry Dryer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read it thoroughly before use and keep it for future reference.

This compact electric dryer is designed for small laundry loads, making it ideal for apartments, dorms, or RVs where space is limited. It offers convenient drying options with two heat levels and an Air Dry setting, operating on a standard 110-Volt (120 VAC, 15 Amp) outlet.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

### 2.1 General Safety Precautions

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not dry articles that have been previously cleaned in, washed in, soaked in, or spotted with gasoline, dry-cleaning solvents, or other flammable or explosive substances, as they emit vapors that could ignite or explode.
- Do not allow children to play on or in the appliance. Close supervision of children is necessary when the appliance is used near children.
- Do not reach into the appliance when the drum is moving.

- Do not install or store this appliance where it will be exposed to the weather.
- Do not tamper with controls.
- Do not repair or replace any part of the appliance or attempt any servicing unless specifically recommended in this manual or in published user-repair instructions that you understand and have the skills to carry out.
- Before removing the appliance from service or discarding it, remove the door to the drying compartment.
- Do not use fabric softeners or products to eliminate static unless recommended by the manufacturer of the fabric softener or product.
- Do not use heat to dry articles containing foam rubber or similarly textured rubber-like materials.
- Clean the lint screen before or after each load.
- Keep the area around the exhaust opening and adjacent surrounding areas free from the accumulation of lint, dust, and dirt.
- The interior of the appliance and exhaust duct should be cleaned periodically by qualified service personnel.
- This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

## Parts and Features

- **Door:** Front-loading access to the drum.
- **Drum:** Stainless steel interior where clothes are tumbled.
- **Lint Filter:** Collects lint during drying; located inside the drum.
- **Air Intake Shroud:** Area for air intake.
- **Heat Level Button:** Selects High or Low heat.
- **Timer Knob:** Sets the drying time and selects Air Dry.

## 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

### 4.1 Placement

The compact design of this dryer allows for versatile placement options:

- **Countertop Placement:** Place the dryer on a stable, flat surface. Ensure adequate clearance around the unit for ventilation.
- **Wall Mounting:** A wall mounting kit is included for secure installation. Follow the detailed instructions provided in the separate wall mounting guide for proper and safe installation.
- **Free Standing:** The dryer can also be used as a standalone unit on its four included legs.

## 4.2 Electrical Requirements

The Magic Chef Compact Electric Laundry Dryer operates on a standard household electrical outlet, eliminating the need for special wiring.

- **Voltage:** 110-Volt (120 VAC, 15 Amp) outlet.
- Ensure the outlet is properly grounded and can support the dryer's power requirements.

## 4.3 Venting

Proper venting is crucial for efficient drying and to prevent lint buildup. The dryer includes an exhaust opening designed for connection to a standard 4-inch dryer hose (adapter included).

- Connect a dryer vent hose to the exhaust opening at the rear of the unit.
- Direct the exhaust hose to an outdoor vent or a suitable indoor lint trap system.
- Ensure the hose is not kinked or obstructed to allow for proper airflow.

# 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 5.1 Control Panel Overview

The control panel features a heat selection button and a timer knob for easy operation.

- **Heat Button:** Press to toggle between HIGH and LOW heat settings.
- **Timer Knob:** Rotate clockwise to select desired drying time (in minutes) or the Air Dry setting. The dryer will automatically turn off when the timer reaches 'OFF'.

## 5.2 Drying Cycles

Select the appropriate heat level and drying time based on your fabric type and load size.

Setting	Description	Recommended Use
HIGH Heat	Provides maximum heat for faster drying.	Heavy fabrics, towels, denim, cotton.
LOW Heat	Provides lower heat to protect delicate fabrics.	Synthetics, delicates, permanent press.

Setting	Description	Recommended Use
AIR DRY	Tumbles clothes without heat.	Fluffing items, refreshing clothes, items sensitive to heat.

### 5.3 Anti-Wrinkle Feature

The dryer includes an Anti-Wrinkle selection that provides periodic tumbling at the end of a dryer cycle. This helps to reduce wrinkling if clothes are not removed immediately after the cycle finishes.

## 6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

### 6.1 Lint Filter Cleaning

To maintain drying efficiency and prevent fire hazards, clean the lint filter before or after every load.

1. Open the dryer door.
2. Locate the lint filter inside the drum.
3. Remove the lint filter by pulling it out.
4. Peel off any accumulated lint from the screen.
5. Reinsert the lint filter firmly into its position.

### 6.2 Exterior Cleaning

Clean the exterior surfaces of the dryer regularly to keep it looking new.

- Wipe down the exterior with a soft, damp cloth and mild detergent.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish.
- Ensure the dryer is unplugged before cleaning.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, please refer to the following table for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dryer does not start.	Not plugged in; circuit breaker tripped; door not closed properly; timer not set.	Check power cord; reset breaker; ensure door is latched; set timer.
Clothes not drying completely.	Lint filter clogged; overloaded dryer; improper heat setting; restricted airflow.	Clean lint filter; reduce load size; select appropriate heat; check vent hose for kinks.
Dryer is noisy.	Foreign objects in drum; dryer not level.	Check drum for loose items; ensure dryer is on a level surface.
Clothes are wrinkled.	Overloaded dryer; clothes left in dryer too long after cycle.	Reduce load size; remove clothes promptly or use Anti-Wrinkle feature.


