## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Sommer Slider+ S10305 TX40-868-4 garage door remote control. Designed for use with Sommer Base+ and Pro+ drive systems, this remote offers secure and convenient operation of your garage door. Please read these instructions carefully before use to ensure proper function and safety.

## 2. KEY FEATURES

---

- **Retrocompatible:** Works with the Somloq Rollingcode radio system, allowing control of existing drives and wireless receivers.
- **Modern Design:** High-quality construction with a stainless steel finish.
- **Sliding Function:** Features a protective slider to prevent unintentional button presses.
- **Compact Size:** Easily attaches to a keychain for portability.
- **SOMloq2 Radio System:** Offers maximum security against unauthorized access through AES 128-bit encryption with a rolling code.
- **Automatic Repeat Function:** Enables comfortable opening as you approach the object.
- **Enhanced Range & Reliability:** Improved performance due to the Hop function, where the signal is actively transmitted by the SOMloq2 receiver.
- **Multiple Commands:** Supports 4 distinct radio commands.

## 3. SETUP AND PROGRAMMING

---

To program your Sommer Slider+ S10305 remote control with your garage door opener (e.g., Sommer Base+ or Pro+ drive), follow these steps:

1. **Locate the Control Unit:** Find the control unit of your garage door motor. Open its cover to access the programming button.
2. **Identify Programming Button:** Identify the programming button, often labeled 'Radio' or similar. It is usually located near a small hole. Use a small, non-conductive object like a toothpick to press this button.
3. **Activate Programming Mode:** A small red indicator light on the control unit will illuminate, indicating it is in programming mode.
4. **Position Remote:** Take your new Sommer Slider+ remote control. Position it close to the red indicator light on the control unit.
5. **Press and Hold Remote Button:** Press and hold the button on the remote control that you wish to program for opening/closing the garage door.
6. **Confirm Programming:** Continue holding the button until the red indicator light on the control unit stops flashing rapidly and then extinguishes. This indicates successful programming.
7. **Test Remote:** Release the button on the remote control. Test the remote by pressing the programmed button. The garage door should now operate.

**Note:** Ensure your garage door opener is compatible with the SOMloq2 radio system and the 868.8 MHz / 868.95 MHz frequencies. Some regional variations of Sommer products exist; verify compatibility if issues arise.

## 4. OPERATION

---

The Sommer Slider+ S10305 remote control features a sliding cover to protect the buttons from accidental presses. To operate your garage door:

1. **Slide Down Cover:** Gently slide the protective cover down to reveal the control buttons.
2. **Press Button:** Press the desired, pre-programmed button to activate your garage door opener. Each button can be programmed for a different function or to control a different door.
3. **Slide Up Cover:** After use, slide the cover back up to protect the buttons and prevent unintended activation.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND BATTERY REPLACEMENT

---

The remote control is powered by one CR123A battery. When the remote's range decreases or it stops responding, the battery may need replacement.

Battery Replacement:

1. **Open Casing:** Carefully open the remote control casing. This typically involves gently prying apart the two halves or removing a small screw if present.
2. **Remove Old Battery:** Remove the old CR123A battery from its compartment.
3. **Insert New Battery:** Insert a new CR123A battery, ensuring correct polarity (+ and -).
4. **Close Casing:** Close the remote control casing securely until it clicks into place.

Dispose of old batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

Cleaning:

Clean the remote control with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Sommer Slider+ S10305 remote control is not functioning as expected, consider the following:

- **Remote not responding:**
  - Check the battery. Replace it with a new CR123A battery if necessary.
  - Ensure the remote is within the operating range (50-140 meters) of the receiver.
  - Verify that the remote is correctly programmed to your garage door opener. Repeat the programming steps if unsure.
- **Reduced range:**
  - Replace the battery.
  - Check for sources of interference (e.g., other radio devices, large metal objects, thick walls) near the remote or the receiver.
  - Ensure the antenna on your garage door opener is unobstructed.
- **Remote programmed but not working (especially in certain regions):**
  - Some Sommer products have regional codes (e.g., S10305-0001 vs. S10305-00075). Ensure the specific model you have is compatible with your region's garage door opener. Incompatible regional codes can prevent proper function.
  - Consult your garage door opener's manual or the manufacturer for regional compatibility information.
