4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Careful installation is crucial for the proper function of the valve.

Tools Required:

- PVC cement and primer (if applicable)
- Pipe cutters or saw
- Measuring tape
- Clean rags

Installation Steps:

1. **System Preparation:** Turn off all pumps and disconnect power to the system. Close any upstream and downstream valves to isolate the installation area. Drain the lines if necessary.

6. **Curing Time:** Allow adequate curing time for the PVC cement as recommended by the manufacturer before pressurizing the system.
7. **System Restart:** Once cured, slowly open upstream and downstream valves, then restore power and restart the pump. Check for leaks.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The HydroAir Hydroflow 3-Way Valve features a simple handle for controlling water flow. The handle typically indicates the direction of flow or the port that is open/closed.

- **Diverting Flow:** Rotate the handle to direct water from a single inlet to one of two outlets.
- **Mixing Flow:** Position the handle to combine water from two inlets into a single outlet.
- **Off Position:** Some 3-way valves may have an 'off' or 'closed' position that stops flow to all ports, or to specific ports depending on the design. Refer to the markings on your specific valve for precise control.

Always turn the handle smoothly and avoid excessive force to prevent damage to the internal components.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your valve.

Routine Maintenance:

- **Visual Inspection:** Periodically inspect the valve for any signs of leaks, cracks, or damage to the body or handle.
- **O-Ring Inspection:** If the valve can be disassembled, inspect the O-rings for wear or damage. Replace if necessary.
- **Lubrication:** If the handle becomes stiff, apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant (safe for pool/spa use) to the O-rings or moving parts, if accessible.
- **Cleaning:** Keep the exterior of the valve clean from dirt and debris.

Winterization (for outdoor/seasonal use):

- **Drain Water:** Ensure all water is drained from the valve and associated plumbing to prevent freezing and cracking.

- **Open Position:** Leave the valve in a partially open position to allow for expansion if any residual water freezes.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Valve is leaking	Improper installation, damaged O-rings/seals, cracked valve body	Check connections for proper sealing. Inspect and replace O-rings/seals. If valve body is cracked, replace the entire valve.
Handle is stiff or hard to turn	Lack of lubrication, debris inside valve, worn internal components	Disconnect power and relieve pressure. Disassemble (if possible) and clean out debris. Lubricate O-rings with silicone lubricant. If problem persists, replacement may be necessary.
Incomplete flow diversion	Debris obstructing internal mechanism, worn diverter	Disconnect power and relieve pressure. Inspect internal components for debris and clear. If diverter is worn, valve replacement is recommended.
