INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the operation and care of your Driven by Battat 7-Inch Dump Truck Toy. This toy features realistic lights, sounds, and movable parts designed for interactive play. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper function and safety.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Attention! Not suitable for children under 3 years old.

This product contains small parts which may pose a choking hazard. Adult supervision is recommended during play. Ensure all battery compartments are securely closed to prevent access by children.

SETUP

Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the dump truck.
2. Using a small screwdriver (not included), open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 3 LR44 batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). The batteries are included with the toy.
4. Securely close the battery compartment cover with the screwdriver.

Note: For optimal performance, use fresh batteries. Replace batteries when lights dim or sounds become faint.

Initial Inspection

Before first use, inspect the toy for any loose or damaged parts. If any damage is found, discontinue use and contact customer support.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Lights and Sounds

To activate the realistic lights and sounds, press down on the hood of the dump truck. This will trigger engine sounds, horn honking, and illuminate the headlights.

Movable Parts

- **Dump Bed:** The truck bed can be manually tilted upwards to simulate dumping its payload. The tailgate also opens and closes for realistic loading and unloading.

Rolling Action

- **Storage:** Store the toy in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.
- **Battery Replacement:** Refer to the 'Battery Installation' section for instructions on replacing the LR44 batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Lights or Sounds:**
 - Ensure the batteries are correctly installed with proper polarity.
 - Replace old or depleted batteries with new LR44 batteries.
 - Check if the battery compartment cover is securely closed.

- **Movable Parts Sticking:**

- Inspect for any debris or foreign objects obstructing the movement of the dump bed, tailgate, or doors.
- Gently clean the moving parts if necessary.
