INTRODUCTION

SETUP

The LP Americana 2-Voice Cajon is designed for immediate play with minimal setup. Follow these guidelines for optimal use:

1. **Positioning:** Place the cajon on a stable, flat surface. The cajon is designed to be sat upon, with the front plate facing forward. Ensure a comfortable and balanced seating position.
2. **Two-Voice Design:** This cajon features a double-sided birch front plate. One side offers a textured snare sound,

while the other provides a distinct, non-snare tone. Simply rotate the cajon to utilize the desired playing surface.

3. **Snare Wire:** The cajon includes a fixed 1x20 DW snare wire. This internal snare system is not adjustable, providing a consistent snare effect on the designated side.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Playing the cajon involves striking different areas of the front plate with your hands to produce a variety of sounds. Experiment with different hand positions and striking techniques to explore the full sonic range of your instrument.

- **Bass Tone:** Strike the center of the front plate with your palm and flat fingers for a deep bass sound.
- **Snare Sound:** On the textured snare side, strike the top edge of the front plate with your fingertips for a crisp snare effect. Varying the pressure and position will alter the snare's intensity.
- **Open Tone:** On the non-snare side, strike the top edge with your fingertips for an open, woody tone.
- **Two-Voice Playability:** The double-sided design allows for quick transitions between snare and non-snare sounds by simply rotating the cajon. This offers enhanced versatility during performance.

For visual demonstrations of playing techniques, consider searching for general cajon playing tutorials online. While no specific product videos are available from the seller for this model, many resources can guide you in mastering the instrument.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and preserve the sound quality of your cajon.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the cajon's surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the wood finish.
- **Storage:** Store the cajon in a stable environment away from extreme temperature changes, direct sunlight, and high humidity. These conditions can cause the wood to warp or crack.
- **Handling:** Handle the cajon with care to prevent dents or scratches to the playing surfaces and body.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues with a cajon are related to playing technique or environmental factors. As the snare wire is fixed and not adjustable, sound variations are primarily achieved through playing style.

- **Dull Sound:** Ensure you are striking the appropriate areas of the front plate. Experiment with different hand shapes and pressures.
- **Rattling Noise (other than snare):** Check for any loose objects inside the cajon or external vibrations.
- **Wood Warping/Cracking:** This is often due to improper storage. Refer to the 'Maintenance' section for guidance on environmental conditions.
