INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for setting up and playing the USAOPOLY MONOPOLY Dragon Ball Z Board Game. Familiarize yourself with the components and rules to ensure an enjoyable gaming experience.

GAME COMPONENTS

The MONOPOLY Dragon Ball Z Board Game includes the following items:

- Custom Game Board
- 6 Collectible Tokens: Trunk's Sword, DynoCap, 4-Star Dragon Ball, Dragon Radar, Saiyan Armor, Turtle Shell
- Custom Themed Monopoly Money
- Capsule Corp Cards (replacing Chance cards)
- Red Ribbon Army Cards (replacing Community Chest cards)
- Kame Houses (replacing Houses)
- Hyperbolic Time Chambers (replacing Hotels)
- 32 Title Deed Cards
- 2 Dice
- Instructions (this manual)

SETUP

1. **Unfold the Game Board:** Place the custom Dragon Ball Z game board on a flat surface.
2. **Separate Components:** Separate the Title Deed cards, Capsule Corp cards, Red Ribbon Army cards, Kame Houses, Hyperbolic Time Chambers, and Monopoly money.
3. **Place Cards:** Shuffle the Capsule Corp cards and place them face down on the designated "Capsule Corp" space on the board. Shuffle the Red Ribbon Army cards and place them face down on the designated "Red Ribbon Army" space.
4. **Banker Selection:** Each player rolls one die. The player with the highest roll becomes the Banker. The Banker is responsible for the bank's money, Kame Houses, Hyperbolic Time Chambers, and Title Deeds. The Banker may also play, but must keep their personal funds separate from the bank's.
5. **Initial Funds:** The Banker distributes starting money to each player. Refer to the official Monopoly rules for the standard starting amount (typically \$1500 in various denominations).
6. **Choose Tokens:** Each player selects one of the 6 collectible tokens to represent them on the board.
7. **Starting Position:** All players place their chosen token on the "GO" space.

OPERATING (GAME RULES)

The MONOPOLY Dragon Ball Z Board Game follows the classic Monopoly rules with a Dragon Ball Z theme. The objective is to be the last player remaining with money, having driven all other players into bankruptcy.

Gameplay Overview:

- Players take turns rolling two dice and moving their token clockwise around the board.
- Landing on an unowned property allows the player to purchase it. If they decline, the property is auctioned.
- Landing on an owned property requires paying rent to the owner.
- Collecting property sets allows players to build Kame Houses and Hyperbolic Time Chambers, increasing rent.
- Landing on "Capsule Corp" or "Red Ribbon Army" spaces requires drawing a card and following its instructions.
- Passing "GO" earns players a salary.
- Players can trade properties with each other.
- The game ends when only one player remains solvent.

Key Thematic Elements:

- **Properties:** Feature iconic Dragon Ball Z characters and locations.
- **Utilities:** Represented by themed elements (e.g., Capsule Corp, Red Ribbon Army).
- **Railroads:** Themed transportation methods or locations.
- **Kame Houses & Hyperbolic Time Chambers:** Themed buildings for properties.
- **Cards:** Capsule Corp and Red Ribbon Army cards provide unique Dragon Ball Z themed events and

instructions.
