INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your PawHut Elevated Dog Bed with Canopy, Model D04-059. This elevated pet cot is designed to provide a comfortable resting space for your dog, both indoors and outdoors, offering airflow and shade.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure all components are securely assembled before allowing your pet to use the bed.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 35 kg (77 lbs).
- Regularly inspect the bed for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Discontinue use if damaged.
- Keep the product away from open flames or excessive heat sources.

- Supervise pets, especially puppies, to prevent chewing on components.
- Place the bed on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all parts are present before beginning assembly:

- Elevated Bed Frame Components (metal tubes, corner connectors)
- Bed Fabric (polyester mesh)
- Canopy Fabric (190T PU Covering Polyester Taffeta)
- Canopy Support Rods
- Bungee Cords (for canopy attachment)
- 210D Oxford Carry Bag
- Assembly Instructions (pictorial)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly typically requires minimal tools and can be completed by one person. Refer to the included pictorial instructions for detailed steps. The following general steps apply:

1. **Assemble the Bed Frame:** Connect the metal tubes using the corner connectors to form the rectangular base. Ensure all connections are firm.
2. **Attach the Bed Fabric:** Lay the bed fabric over the assembled frame. Locate the Velcro flap on one short side of the fabric. Fully open this flap. Stretch the fabric over the frame, ensuring the Velcro flap is positioned correctly to secure the fabric tightly once the frame is fully assembled.
3. **Secure the Fabric:** Once the fabric is stretched over the frame, close the Velcro flap to secure the fabric. This step is crucial for preventing sagging.
4. **Install Canopy Connectors:** Ensure the corner connectors on the bed frame have small holes facing upwards. These are for the canopy support rods.
5. **Assemble the Canopy:** Connect the canopy support rods to form the canopy structure.
6. **Attach the Canopy to the Bed:** Insert the ends of the canopy support rods into the upward-facing holes on the bed frame's corner connectors. Secure the canopy fabric to the frame using the provided bungee cords.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The PawHut Elevated Dog Bed with Canopy is designed for straightforward use:

- **Placement:** Position the bed on a level surface, either indoors or outdoors. The elevated design promotes airflow, keeping your pet cool.
- **Canopy Use:** The canopy provides shade and protection from direct sunlight. It can be easily attached or removed as needed.
- **Portability:** For transport or storage, disassemble the bed and pack it into the included carry bag.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** The bed fabric can be cleaned with mild soap and water. Hand wash only. Allow to air dry completely before reassembly or storage.
- **Frame Care:** Wipe the metal frame with a damp cloth as needed.
- **Storage:** When not in use, disassemble the bed and store it in the provided carry bag in a dry, cool place to prolong its lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed fabric sags excessively.	Fabric not stretched tightly enough during assembly; Velcro flap not secured.	Disassemble and reassemble the bed, ensuring the fabric is pulled taut and the Velcro flap is firmly secured.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Canopy does not stay attached.	Canopy support rods not fully inserted; bungee cords loose or damaged.	Ensure canopy support rods are fully seated in the frame connectors. Check bungee cords for damage and replace if necessary.
Bed feels unstable.	Frame components not fully connected; bed placed on uneven surface.	Verify all frame connections are secure. Move the bed to a flat, stable surface.
