INTRODUCTION

The FreedConn TCOM-SC is a versatile Bluetooth communication system designed for motorcycle helmets. It enables hands-free communication, music streaming, GPS navigation audio, and FM radio reception. Key features include:

- Bluetooth Intercom: Supports communication between 2 riders simultaneously, with up to 3 riders connected, over a
 distance of up to 800 meters in open spaces.
- LCD Screen: Provides clear visual feedback on operating status.
- FM Radio: Allows listening to radio broadcasts during rides.
- Advanced Noise Control: Utilizes DSP (Digital Signal Processor) for echo cancellation and noise suppression, ensuring clear audio.
- Music Sharing: Share music with another paired headset.
- Universal Compatibility: Connects with most Bluetooth-enabled mobile phones, MP3 players, and GPS devices.
- Water Resistant Design: Suitable for various weather conditions.
- Long Battery Life: Up to 10 hours talk time, 7 hours intercom time, and 300 hours standby.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The TCOM-SC is designed for easy installation on most motorcycle helmets. Choose between the hard mic cord for modular and half helmets, or the soft mic cord for full-face helmets.

Installation Steps:

- 1. Attach the intercom unit to the side of your helmet using the sticky clamp or headset clip.
- 2. Insert the stereo headphones into the helmet's ear pockets, ensuring they are positioned correctly for optimal sound.
- 3. Connect the chosen microphone (hard or soft cable) to the headset.
- 4. Route the cables neatly within the helmet lining to avoid interference and ensure comfort.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Controls:

- Power On/Off: Long press the Power/Intercom button.
- Volume Control: Turn the Jog Wheel.
- Music Play/Pause: Press the Multi-function Button.
- Skip Track: Turn the Jog Wheel (while music is playing).
- Answer/End Call: One press of the Multi-function Button.
- Reject Call: One press of the Multi-function Button.
- Redial Last Number: Hold the Multi-function Button for 2 seconds.
- FM Radio On/Off: Double press the Multi-function Button.
- Switch FM Channel: Turn the Jog Wheel (while FM radio is on).

Bluetooth Mobile Pairing:

- 1. Ensure the TCOM-SC unit is powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the Multi-function Button for approximately 5 seconds until the LCD screen displays "PAIRING".
- 3. On your mobile phone, enable Bluetooth and search for "T-COM". Select it to connect.
- 4. Once connected, you can stream music, receive GPS voice prompts, and handle phone calls.




Image: Bluetooth pairing with mobile devices and other intercoms.

Intercom Pairing (Two TCOM-SC Units):

- 1. Ensure both TCOM-SC units are powered on.
- 2. On both units, long press the Power/Intercom button for approximately 5 seconds until the LCD screen displays "PAIRING".
- 3. Short press the Power/Intercom button on one of the units (e.g., Unit A). The units will search for each other and connect.
- 4. Once connected, the LCD will show "INTERCOM". You can now communicate between the two units.
- 5. To disconnect the intercom, short press the Power/Intercom button on either unit.




Image: Illustration of two-rider intercom communication.

Music Sharing:

Music sharing is possible between two paired TCOM-SC headsets after they have been successfully paired for intercom. Ensure no third T-COM unit is paired during this process. Exit intercom status after initial pairing.

- 1. Pair your primary TCOM-SC unit (Unit A) with your mobile phone and start playing music.
- 2. Ensure the second TCOM-SC unit (Unit B) is also powered on.
- 3. Double-click the Power/Intercom button on Unit A to initiate music sharing. Both units will then play the music from Unit A's connected phone.
- 4. To stop music sharing, double-click the Power/Intercom button on Unit A again.

MAINTENANCE

The FreedConn TCOM-SC features a water-resistant design, making it suitable for use in various weather conditions. To ensure longevity and optimal performance:

- Avoid submerging the unit in water.
- Clean the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Ensure all ports are dry before charging or connecting accessories.
- Store the unit in a dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TCOM-SC unit, refer to the following common solutions:

• No Sound or Sound from Only One Speaker:

Ensure the speaker port is securely plugged in. If the issue persists, the speakers may be faulty. Contact customer support for replacement speakers. For optimal sound, ensure speakers are positioned directly over your ears inside the helmet.

• Cannot Achieve 3-Person Intercom:

The TCOM-SC model supports pairing with up to 3 riders but only allows 2 riders to communicate via intercom simultaneously. It can also pair with other brands of Bluetooth headsets.

• Pairing Issues with Older/Newer TCOM-SC Units:

Refer to the specific pairing instructions for mixing new and old versions of TCOM-SC units. Ensure all previous pairing information is cleared before attempting new pairings.
