INTRODUCTION

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

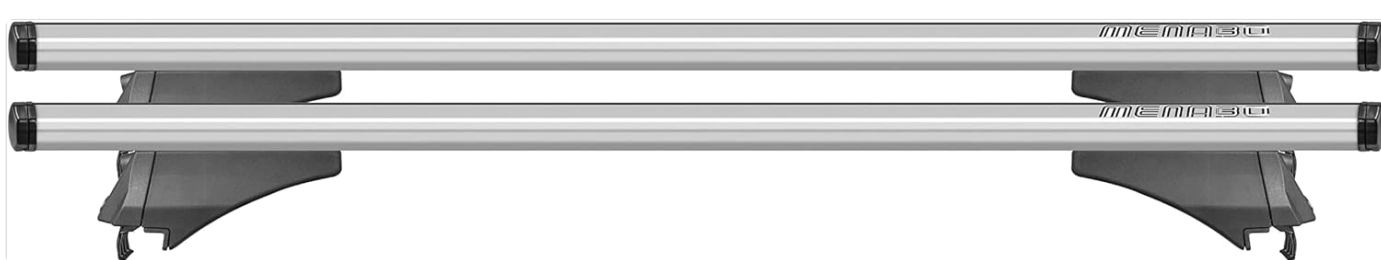


Figure 1: The MENABO Leopard XL Roof Bar set, showcasing its sleek aluminium design.

The MENABO Leopard XL Roof Bar system consists of two aluminium bars and four mounting feet designed to attach securely to your vehicle's roof. Its aerodynamic "blade" profile helps reduce wind noise and drag during travel.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the safety and performance of your roof bars. Follow these steps carefully.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all parts listed in the packing list are present.

2. **Identify Bar Orientation:** The roof bars are designed with an aerodynamic profile. Ensure they are oriented correctly with the wider, leading edge facing forward.
3. **Attach Mounting Feet:** Securely attach the mounting feet to the roof bars according to the specific instructions provided with your vehicle's fit kit (sold separately or included depending on vehicle model). The quick and convenient fixing system allows for straightforward attachment.

4. **Position on Vehicle Roof:** Place the assembled roof bars onto your vehicle's roof. Refer to your vehicle's owner's manual or the fit kit instructions for the correct spacing and positioning points.
5. **Secure to Vehicle:** Tighten the mounting feet securely to your vehicle's roof rails or designated mounting points. Ensure all bolts and clamps are firmly fastened. Do not overtighten.

6. **Test Security:** After installation, gently pull and push on the roof bars to ensure they are firmly attached and do not wobble. Re-check all fastenings after the first few miles of driving.

Important Safety Note: Always adhere to the maximum load capacity of 75 kg (165 lbs) for the roof bars and your vehicle's roof. Exceeding this limit can lead to damage or accidents.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed, your MENABO Leopard XL Roof Bars are ready for use. Consider the following guidelines for optimal performance and safety:

- **Load Distribution:** Distribute the load evenly across the roof bars. Place heavier items closer to the center of the vehicle.
- **Secure Loads:** Always use appropriate straps, nets, or carriers to secure your cargo to the roof bars. Ensure items cannot shift, slide, or fall off during transit.
- **Check Clearance:** Be mindful of increased vehicle height when carrying items on the roof, especially when entering garages, car washes, or low-clearance areas.
- **Driving Habits:** Adjust your driving speed and style when carrying a load on the roof. Avoid sudden braking, sharp turns, or high speeds, as this can affect vehicle stability.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check the security of the roof bars and the load during long journeys.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your MENABO Leopard XL Roof Bars.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the aluminium bars and plastic components with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all components for signs of wear, damage, or corrosion. Check bolts and fasteners for tightness.
- **Storage:** If removing the roof bars for extended periods, store them in a dry, clean place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Lubrication:** Moving parts or locking mechanisms may benefit from occasional lubrication with a silicone-based spray.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their potential solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Roof bars feel loose after installation.	Fasteners not tightened sufficiently.	Re-tighten all mounting bolts and clamps according to the installation instructions. Ensure proper torque if specified.
Excessive wind noise.	Incorrect bar orientation or improper sealing.	Ensure the "blade" profile is facing forward. Check if all end caps and rubber strips are properly seated.
Difficulty attaching accessories.	T-slot channel obstructed or incompatible accessory.	Clear any debris from the T-slot channel. Ensure your accessory is compatible with the MENABO T-slot system.
