## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Lenovo ThinkCentre M710q Tiny desktop computer (Model 10MR0004US). The compact design allows it to fit in various environments, while its robust engineering ensures reliable performance.

## SETUP

### 1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the following items are present:

- Lenovo ThinkCentre M710q Tiny Desktop Computer
- USB Keyboard
- USB Mouse
- 65W Power Adapter
- Floor Stand (optional accessory)

### 2. Connecting Peripherals

Connect your monitor, keyboard, mouse, and power adapter to the appropriate ports on the ThinkCentre M710q Tiny.

- **Power:** Connect the 65W power adapter to the power input port.
- **Display:** Connect your monitor using either the Display Port or VGA port.
- **Keyboard & Mouse:** Plug the USB keyboard and mouse into any of the available USB 3.0 ports.
- **Network:** For wired network access, connect an Ethernet cable to the RJ-45 port. For wireless, ensure the Intel 8265 Dual Band AC Wireless is enabled.
- **Audio:** Use the audio ports for headphones or external speakers.

### 3. Initial Power On

Press the power button located on the front of the device. The system will boot into Windows 10 Pro 64-bit. Follow the on-screen instructions for initial setup, including language, region, and user account creation.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Windows 10 Pro

Your ThinkCentre M710q Tiny comes preloaded with Windows 10 Pro 64-bit. Familiarize yourself with the operating system's interface and features. Regular updates are recommended for optimal performance and security.

### Connectivity

- **USB Devices:** Utilize the 6 USB 3.0 ports and 2 USB 2.0 ports for connecting external drives, printers,

or other USB peripherals.

- **Bluetooth:** The integrated Bluetooth 4.1 allows for wireless connection to compatible devices such as headphones, speakers, or mobile phones.
- **Wireless Network:** Connect to Wi-Fi networks using the Intel 8265 Dual Band AC Wireless for high-speed internet access.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### General Care

Keep the desktop in a clean, dust-free environment. Avoid placing heavy objects on top of the unit or blocking ventilation openings. The chassis intrusion switch is a security feature; avoid tampering with it.

### Cleaning

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the device. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth with mild cleaning solution can be used. Ensure the device is powered off and unplugged before cleaning.

### Software Updates

Regularly check for and install operating system and driver updates to ensure system stability, security, and performance. Windows Update can be configured to automatically download and install updates.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your ThinkCentre M710q Tiny.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
System does not power on.	Power cable disconnected, faulty power adapter, or power outlet issue.	Verify power cable connection, test power adapter with another device if possible, or try a different power outlet.
No display on monitor.	Incorrect display cable connection, monitor off, or incorrect input source selected on monitor.	Check display cable connections (Display Port/VGA), ensure monitor is powered on, and select the correct input source on the monitor.
"No operating system found" error.	Operating system corruption or hard drive issue.	Restart the system. If the issue persists, consult the Lenovo support website for recovery options or contact technical support.
Peripheral (keyboard/mouse) not responding.	Loose USB connection, faulty peripheral, or driver issue.	Ensure USB connections are secure, try a different USB port, or test the peripheral on another computer. Update drivers if necessary.
