1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Holstein Housewares HH-09037016E Waffle Maker. This appliance is designed to prepare delicious waffles quickly and efficiently. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the appliance to ensure safe and optimal performance. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

1. Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
2. Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
3. To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
4. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
5. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
6. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Contact customer service for examination, repair, or adjustment.
7. The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
8. Do not use outdoors.
9. Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
10. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
11. Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
12. To disconnect, remove plug from wall outlet.
13. Do not use the appliance for other than intended use.

3. PARTS IDENTIFICATION

- **Non-stick Cooking Plates:** For easy waffle release and cleaning.
- **Indicator Lights:** Signal when the appliance is powered on and ready for use.
- **Handle:** For safe opening and closing of the lid.
- **Cord Wrap:** Located at the base for convenient storage.

4. BEFORE FIRST USE

1. Unpack the waffle maker and remove all packaging materials.
2. Wipe the cooking plates with a damp cloth or sponge. Dry thoroughly.
3. For the first use, it is recommended to lightly grease the non-stick plates with a small amount of cooking oil or butter. This helps condition the non-stick surface.
4. Plug the appliance into a standard electrical outlet. The indicator light will illuminate. Allow the appliance to heat up for approximately 3-5 minutes until the 'ready' indicator light (if present) signals, or until the initial manufacturing odor dissipates. This is normal for new appliances.
5. Unplug and allow to cool completely before storing.

5. How to Use

1. Ensure the waffle maker is clean and dry.
2. Plug the appliance into a suitable electrical outlet. The power indicator light will turn on.

3. Allow the waffle maker to preheat with the lid closed until the 'ready' indicator light illuminates (approximately 3-5 minutes).
4. Carefully open the lid using the handle.
5. Pour your desired waffle batter onto the center of the bottom cooking plate. Do not overfill, as batter will expand during cooking.
6. Gently close the lid.
7. Cook for approximately 3-6 minutes, or until the waffle is golden brown and cooked to your preference. Cooking time may vary based on batter type and desired crispness.
8. Once cooked, carefully open the lid and remove the waffle using a heat-resistant, non-metallic utensil (e.g., plastic or wooden spatula) to avoid damaging the non-stick coating.
9. Close the lid to maintain heat if making additional waffles.
10. When finished, unplug the appliance from the outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.

6. CARE AND CLEANING

Proper care and cleaning will extend the life of your waffle maker.

1. Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. Wipe the exterior of the waffle maker with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they may damage the finish.
3. To clean the non-stick cooking plates, gently wipe them with a soft, damp cloth or sponge. For stubborn residue, a small amount of mild dish soap can be used. Ensure all soap residue is wiped away.
4. Do not immerse the waffle maker in water or any other liquid.
5. Never use metal utensils, abrasive pads, or harsh chemicals on the non-stick surfaces, as this will scratch and damage the coating.
6. Ensure the appliance is completely dry before storing.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Waffle not cooking evenly:** Ensure the waffle maker is fully preheated before adding batter. Distribute batter evenly across the plate.
- **Waffles sticking to plates:** Ensure the non-stick plates were lightly greased before first use and periodically if needed. Do not use metal utensils that can damage the coating.

- **Appliance not turning on:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- **Smoke or odor during first use:** This is normal for new appliances and should dissipate after a few minutes of initial operation. Ensure adequate ventilation.
