1. Introduction

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Unpacking and Placement

- 1. Carefully remove the display from its packaging. Due to its size and weight (approximately 384 pounds), it is recommended that multiple individuals assist with unpacking and placement to prevent injury or damage.
- 2. Place the display on a stable, level surface or mount it securely using a compatible VESA mount (sold separately). Ensure adequate ventilation around the display.
- 3. Keep the display away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and areas with high humidity.

3.2 Connecting Power and Devices

- 1. Connect the power cord to the display's power input and then to a grounded 110V AC power outlet.
- 2. Connect your source device (e.g., computer, laptop) to the display using an appropriate video cable (HDMI, DisplayPort, VGA).
- 3. For touch functionality, connect a USB cable from your source device to the display's USB upstream port.
- 4. If external audio is desired, connect audio cables as needed, or rely on the display's built-in stereo speakers.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Powering On/Off

- To power on the display, press the power button located on the side or bottom bezel. The power indicator light will illuminate.
- To power off, press and hold the power button until the display shuts down.

4.2 Using Touch Functionality

- Ensure the USB cable for touch is connected between the display and your computer.
- The display supports 10-point multi-touch, allowing multiple users to interact simultaneously.
- Use your finger or a compatible stylus to tap, drag, pinch, and zoom on the screen, similar to a large tablet.

4.3 Input Source Selection

- Use the input selection button on the display's control panel or remote control to cycle through available input sources (HDMI, DisplayPort, VGA).
- Select the input corresponding to your connected source device.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Display

- Always power off and unplug the display before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a non-abrasive, screen-safe cleaning solution.
- Gently wipe the screen and bezel. Avoid excessive moisture and harsh chemicals, which can damage the surface.

5.2 General Care

- Avoid placing heavy objects on the display or applying excessive pressure to the screen.
- Ensure proper ventilation to prevent overheating.
- Do not attempt to repair the display yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Sharp Interactive Display, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Power cord disconnected; Power outlet faulty; Display not turned on.	Check power cord connection; Test outlet with another device; Press the power button firmly.
No Display/Image	Incorrect input source selected; Video cable loose or faulty; Source device not outputting signal.	Select correct input source; Reconnect video cable; Check source device's display settings.
Touch Function Not Working	USB touch cable disconnected; Driver issue on source device; Display in incorrect mode.	Ensure USB touch cable is securely connected; Install/update touch drivers on your computer; Restart both display and source device.
No Audio	Volume too low; Muted; Audio cable disconnected; Incorrect audio output selected on source device.	Increase volume; Unmute display/source; Check audio cable connections; Select display as audio output on source device.
