SETUP

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: If a disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth (like a microfiber cloth) from the center

outwards. Do not use abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.

- **Storage:** Store discs in their original cases, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. Keep them in a vertical position to prevent warping.
- Avoid Scratches: Be careful when inserting or removing discs from the player or cases to prevent scratches.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing your DVDs, consider the following:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Disc not playing / "No Disc" error	Disc inserted incorrectly, dirty disc, or player issue.	Ensure disc is inserted correctly (label side up). Clean the disc. Try another disc to check if the player is functioning.
Skipping or Freezing	Scratched or dirty disc, or dust in player's lens.	Clean the disc thoroughly. If the problem persists with multiple discs, consider cleaning your DVD player's lens with a specialized cleaning disc.
No Audio	TV/player volume too low, incorrect audio track selected, or audio cables disconnected.	Increase volume. Check audio settings on your player/TV. Ensure audio cables are securely connected.
No Video	Incorrect TV input selected, video cables disconnected, or TV/player issue.	Select the correct TV input. Check video cables (HDMI, AV) for secure connection.

If these steps do not resolve the issue, consult your DVD player's manual or contact the player's manufacturer for further assistance.
