PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Graf von Gerlitz Walking Stick correctly enhances stability and safety.

- **Holding the Stick:** Hold the walking stick in the hand opposite to your weaker leg or side. If using for general balance, hold it in your dominant hand.
- **Walking Technique:**
 - Move the stick forward simultaneously with your weaker leg.
 - Step forward with your stronger leg, passing the stick.
 - Maintain a natural walking rhythm.
- **Stairs:**
 - *Going Up:* Lead with your stronger leg, then bring the stick and weaker leg up to the same step.
 - *Going Down:* Place the stick on the lower step first, then bring your weaker leg down, followed by your stronger leg.
- **Surface Awareness:** Always be mindful of the walking surface. The stick provides best grip on dry, even surfaces. Exercise caution on wet, icy, or uneven terrain.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your walking stick.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the shaft and handle with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish. For the ornate handle, a dry, soft cloth is recommended to maintain its luster.
- **Tip Replacement:** Regularly inspect the rubber or metal tip at the bottom. If it shows significant wear, cracking, or becomes smooth, replace it immediately to prevent slipping. Replacement tips can typically be purchased from mobility aid suppliers.
- **Handle Security:** Periodically check that the handle remains firmly attached to the shaft. If it becomes loose, it may require professional attention or tightening if designed to be user-serviceable (this model is not designed for user tightening).
- **Storage:** Store the walking stick in a dry place, away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight, to preserve the material integrity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common issues and their resolutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stick slips on surfaces.	Worn or damaged rubber tip; wet/slippery surface.	Replace the tip. Exercise extreme caution on wet or icy surfaces.
Handle feels loose.	Connection between handle and shaft has loosened.	This model is not designed for user tightening. Discontinue use and contact the manufacturer or a qualified repair service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stick makes creaking noises.	Internal components shifting; material stress.	Inspect for visible damage. If noises persist or worsen, discontinue use and seek professional advice.
