This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, installation, and maintenance of your ClosetMaid SuiteSymphony 16-Inch Tower Kit with Shelves and 2 Drawers in Natural Gray. Please read thoroughly before beginning installation.

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ClosetMaid SuiteSymphony 16-Inch Tower Kit is a modular closet organization system designed to enhance storage and organization. This kit includes a central tower with shelves, two drawers, and adjustable hanging rods, suitable for various closet sizes.



4. SETUP & INSTALLATION

This section outlines the steps for assembling and installing your ClosetMaid SuiteSymphony organizer. It is recommended to have a second person assist with installation. Ensure the unit is securely mounted to the wall for stability.

4.1 Pre-Installation Considerations

- Closet Width Compatibility: This system fits closets 5 to 9 feet wide.
 - For 5 ft. wide closets: Rods fully extended to 48 in. W, top shelves installed on one side of the tower.
 - For 9 ft. wide closets: Rods fully extended to 48 in. W, top shelves installed on both sides of the tower.
- Adjustments for Smaller Closets: Adjustable rods (30-48 inches) and 48-inch wide top shelves can be trimmed to fit smaller spaces. Refer to sections 4.3 and 4.4 for cutting instructions.
- Tools Required: Basic household tools such as a tape measure, level, screwdriver, drill, and potentially a saw
 for trimming components.

4.2 Assembly Steps (General Overview)

- 1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Lay out all components and hardware. Refer to the included parts list to ensure everything is present.
- 2. **Assemble the Tower:** Follow the detailed instructions provided in the hardware kit to construct the central tower unit, including the fixed and adjustable shelves.
- 3. **Install Drawers:** Assemble the two drawers and install them into the designated slots within the tower using the full extension glides.
- 4. Position the Tower: Place the assembled tower in its desired location within the closet.
- 5. **Mount to Wall:** Securely attach the tower to the wall using the provided mounting hardware. This step is crucial for stability and safety.
- 6. **Install Top Shelves and Support Brackets:**Attach the top shelves to the sides of the tower using the support brackets. Ensure they are level.
- 7. Install Adjustable Rods: Extend the adjustable rods to the required length and install them beneath the top

4.3 How to Cut Top Shelves (If Necessary)

If your closet space requires shorter top shelves, follow these steps:

- 1. **Measure:** Determine the necessary length for your top shelves. Remember to account for the width of the central tower.
- 2. **Prepare:** Mark the cutting line on the shelf. Apply painter's tape or similar thick tape along the cut line to help prevent chipping or cracking during the cut.
- 3. **Cut:** Use a hand saw or circular saw with a fine-toothed blade suitable for cutting wood. Always wear eye protection and follow all safety precautions when using power tools.





Why would you cut a top shelf?

After purchase, if you find that our top shelves won't fit inside your space, you can cut them down to the exact length you need.

- What materials are used?
 - Tape Measure
 - Painter's Tape (or other thick tape)
 - Hand Saw or Circular Saw*

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



MEASURING

Measure the width of your space to determine the necessary length of your top shelves. Remember to account for the width of the tower.



PREPPING

Prepare the shelf by marking the length and placing a strip of thick tape where you will make the cut. This will help prevent chipping or cracking.



CUTTING

Use a hand saw or a circular saw* to cut top shelves. Always use a narrow, fine-toothed blade that is suitable for cutting wood.

* Always take safety precautions, such as wearing eye protection, when using power tools.

4.4 How to Cut Hang Rods (If Necessary)

If your closet space requires shorter hang rods, follow these steps:

- 1. **Measure:** Determine the necessary length for your hang rods. For spaces less than 30 inches, the rod will need to be cut. Account for the width of the tower and 1/4 inch space on each side for the hang rod brackets.
- 2. **Prepare:** Separate the inner rod from the outer rod. Mark the necessary length on the outer rod. Do not cut the end of the rod with pre-drilled mounting holes. When rejoining, the rods need to overlap by a minimum of 4 inches.
- 3. **Cut:** Use a pipe cutter or hacksaw to cut the rod. Sand the cut end to remove any sharp edges before installation.





Why would you cut a hang rod?

After purchase, if you find that our hang rods won't fit inside your space, you can cut them down to the exact length you need.

- What materials are used?
 - Tape Measure
 - Pipe Cutter or Hacksaw

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



MEASURING

Measure the width of your closet to determine the necessary length of your hang rods. For any space less than 30 inches, the hang rod will need to be cut. Remember to account for the width of the tower and for 1/4 inch space on each side of the rod for the hang rod brackets.



PREPPING

Begin by separating the inner rod from the outer rod and marking the necessary lengths on the side of each rod. Do not cut the ends of the rods with pre-drilled mounting holes. When rejoining, the rods need to overlap by a minimum of 4 inches.



CUTTING

Use a pipe cutter or hacksaw with a fine cutting blade. Sand the cut end to remove any sharp edges before installing.

5. USAGE

The ClosetMaid SuiteSymphony organizer provides versatile storage for various items. Utilize the hanging rods for shirts, pants, and jackets, and the shelves for folded items, shoes, or decor. The two drawers are ideal for small folded items or accessories.

6. MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your ClosetMaid SuiteSymphony organizer, follow these simple guidelines:

- Cleaning: Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.
- Weight Distribution: Distribute weight evenly across shelves and hanging rods to prevent warping or damage. Do not exceed the stated weight capacities (30 lbs for internal shelves, 60 lbs for external shelves).
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary.
- Moisture: Avoid prolonged exposure to excessive moisture, which can cause swelling or damage to the
 engineered wood.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Table 7.1: Common Issues and Solutions

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit feels unstable or wobbly.	Not securely mounted to the wall; loose fasteners.	Ensure the unit is properly anchored to wall studs. Tighten all assembly screws.
Drawers do not slide smoothly.	Improper installation of glides; obstruction in the track.	Verify that drawer glides are installed correctly and are free of debris. Check for proper alignment.
Shelves are sagging.	Overloaded shelves; improper installation.	Reduce weight on shelves, ensuring even distribution. Confirm shelves are fully seated on their supports. Do not exceed weight capacity.
Missing or damaged parts.	Packaging error or transit damage.	Contact ClosetMaid customer support with your proof of purchase within 30 days.
