## SETUP

The WD Elements Portable External Hard Drive is designed for plug-and-play expandability, making setup straightforward.

- Connect the USB Cable:** Take the included SuperSpeed USB-A cable. Connect the smaller end of the cable to the USB port on your WD Elements Portable hard drive.
- Connect to Computer:** Connect the larger USB-A end of the cable to an available USB 3.0 or USB 2.0 port on your computer (PC or Mac). For optimal performance, use a USB 3.0 port.
- Automatic Recognition:** Your operating system (Windows or macOS) should automatically detect and recognize the new hard drive. It will appear as a new drive letter (Windows) or an icon on your desktop/Finder (Mac).
- Ready to Use:** The drive comes pre-formatted and is ready for immediate use. No additional software installation is typically required for basic storage functions.

### MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your WD Elements Portable External Hard Drive.

- **Safe Removal:** Always safely eject or unmount the drive from your operating system before disconnecting the USB cable to prevent data corruption.
- **Keep Clean:** Wipe the exterior of the drive with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using liquid cleaners or solvents.
- **Avoid Physical Shock:** While portable, the drive contains mechanical components. Avoid dropping or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- **Temperature and Humidity:** Store and operate the drive within recommended temperature and humidity ranges to prevent damage.
- **Regular Backups:** While the drive is for storage, it is always recommended to have multiple copies of critical data.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your WD Elements Portable External Hard Drive, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Drive Not Detected:**

- Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the drive and the computer.
- Try connecting to a different USB port on your computer.
- Test the drive with a different USB cable if available.
- Restart your computer.

- **Slow Transfer Speeds:**

- Ensure you are connected to a USB 3.0 port for optimal performance. USB 2.0 ports will result in slower speeds.
- Close other applications that might be using significant system resources.
- Check the health of your computer's internal drive.

- **Drive Disconnects Randomly:**

- Ensure the USB cable is not loose.
- Try a different USB port or a powered USB hub if available.
- Disable USB selective suspend setting in Windows Power Options (for Windows users).

- **Cannot Write Files (Read-Only):**

- If using on a Mac and the drive was formatted for Windows (NTFS), you may need third-party software to enable write access, or reformat the drive to exFAT or HFS+ (Mac OS Extended).
- Check if the drive is full.
