MISTRAL MHV800R High Velocity Power Fan User Manual

Model: MHV800R

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using this appliance and retain them for future reference. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious personal injury.

- Ensure the power supply voltage matches the rating label on the fan.
- Always unplug the fan from the power outlet before cleaning, servicing, or moving it.
- Do not operate the fan with a damaged cord or plug. If the cord or plug is damaged, contact qualified service personnel for repair or replacement.
- Keep fingers, pencils, or any other objects out of the fan grille when it is operating.
- Do not use the fan in wet or damp locations such as bathrooms or laundries.
- Place the fan on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Do not cover the fan or obstruct its airflow during operation.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The MISTRAL MHV800R is an 8-inch high velocity power fan designed for efficient air circulation with the convenience of remote control operation.

Components

- Fan Unit (main body, grille, blades, base, control panel)
- Remote Control

Control Panel

- **POWER Button:** Turns the fan On or Off.
- **TIMER Button:** Sets the operating timer (1, 2, 3, or 4 hours).
- **L-R (Left-Right) Oscillation Button:** Activates or deactivates horizontal oscillation.
- **U-D (Up-Down) Oscillation Button:** Activates or deactivates vertical oscillation.
- **SPEED Button:** Cycles through 4 fan speed settings.

Remote Control

The remote control allows convenient operation of all fan functions from a distance. Ensure batteries are correctly installed (not included, typically 2x AAA).

3. SETUP

- 1. Unpacking:** Carefully remove the fan and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
- 2. Placement:** Place the fan on a firm, level, and stable surface. Ensure there is adequate space around the fan for proper airflow and oscillation. Avoid placing it near curtains or other objects that could obstruct the grilles.
- 3. Power Connection:** Insert the power plug into a suitable electrical outlet. Ensure the outlet meets the fan's power requirements.
- 4. Remote Control Batteries:** If using the remote control, open the battery compartment and insert the required batteries (e.g., 2x AAA, not supplied), observing the correct polarity (+/-).

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The fan can be operated using either the control panel on the unit or the remote control.

Power On/Off

- Press the **POWER** button once to turn the fan On. The fan will start at a low speed.
- Press the **POWER** button again to turn the fan Off.

Speed Selection

- With the fan On, press the **SPEED** button repeatedly to cycle through the 4 available speed settings (Speed 1, Speed 2, Speed 3, Speed 4).
- Indicator lights on the control panel will show the currently selected speed.

Oscillation

- **Left-Right Oscillation:** Press the **L-R** button to activate horizontal oscillation (approximately 60 degrees). Press again to stop.
- **Up-Down Oscillation:** Press the **U-D** button to activate vertical oscillation (approximately 90 degrees). Press again to stop.
- Both oscillation modes can be used simultaneously.

Timer Function

- With the fan On, press the **TIMER** button repeatedly to set the desired operating time (1 hour, 2 hours, 3 hours, or 4 hours).
- The corresponding indicator light(s) on the control panel will illuminate.
- The fan will automatically turn off once the set time has elapsed. To cancel the timer, cycle through the settings until no timer indicator lights are illuminated.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and proper storage will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your fan.

Cleaning

1. **Always unplug the fan** from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. Wipe the exterior surfaces of the fan with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these may damage the finish.
3. For cleaning the fan blades and inside the grilles, use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment or a soft, dry cloth to remove dust. Do not attempt to disassemble the fan for cleaning beyond what is specified.
4. Ensure the fan is completely dry before plugging it back in and operating.

Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the fan in its original packaging or cover it to protect it from dust. Store in a cool, dry place.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your MISTRAL MHV800R fan, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on.	No power supply. Power cord not securely plugged in. Remote control batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted.	Check if the power outlet is working. Ensure the power cord is firmly plugged into the fan and the outlet. Replace remote control batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
Weak or no airflow.	Fan speed is set too low. Air intake/outlet is obstructed. Fan blades are dirty.	Increase the fan speed using the SPEED button. Remove any obstructions from around the fan. Clean the fan blades and grilles as per maintenance instructions.
Fan makes unusual noise.	Fan is not on a stable surface. Foreign object inside the fan grille.	Place the fan on a flat, stable surface. Unplug the fan and carefully check for any foreign objects. Do not attempt to remove objects if it requires disassembly.
Remote control not working.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted. Obstruction between remote and fan.	Replace batteries, ensuring correct polarity. Ensure a clear line of sight between the remote and the fan's receiver.



8. WARRANTY AND SUPPORT


This MISTRAL MHV800R fan comes with a warranty to ensure your peace of mind.
