INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Green Valley Adventure 625 Rear Bicycle Carrier. This manual provides essential information for the safe and correct assembly, operation, and maintenance of your bicycle carrier. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and use, and keep them for future reference. Proper installation and use are crucial for your safety and the safety of others.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these safety instructions could result in serious injury or property damage.

- Always read and understand the entire instruction manual before installation and use.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of the carrier (refer to specifications) or your vehicle's towing/carrying capacity.
- Ensure all straps, bolts, and fasteners are securely tightened before each journey. Check regularly during long trips.
- Verify that the carrier and bicycles do not obstruct vehicle lights, license plates, or rear visibility. Use auxiliary lighting/license plate holders if necessary (sold separately).
- Drive cautiously, especially over bumps, during braking, and when cornering. Adjust driving speed to road conditions and load.
- Be aware of the increased length and width of your vehicle when the carrier is installed.
- Remove the carrier when not in use to improve fuel efficiency and prevent theft.
- Keep children away from the carrier during installation and removal.
- Do not modify the carrier in any way. Use only original Green Valley replacement parts.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, please verify that all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with installation and contact customer support.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps carefully to ensure proper and secure installation of your Green Valley Adventure 625 bicycle carrier.

1. Unpacking and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Inspect each part for any signs of damage or manufacturing defects. Refer to the "Package Contents" section to ensure all items are present.

2. Assembling the Carrier Frame

Connect the main carrier frame sections according to the diagrams provided. Ensure all locking pins or bolts are fully engaged and tightened. Attach the wheel trays to the main frame, ensuring they are spaced correctly for typical bicycle wheelbases. Secure the bicycle frame holders to the vertical support arms.

3. Mounting to the Vehicle

Position the carrier on the rear of your vehicle, ensuring the support pads rest firmly and evenly on the vehicle's surface. Attach the mounting straps to secure anchor points on your vehicle (e.g., trunk lid edges, bumper). Tighten all straps evenly and firmly, ensuring the carrier is stable and does not wobble. Re-check strap tension after driving a short distance.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Loading Bicycles

1. Ensure the carrier is securely mounted to the vehicle.
2. Place the first bicycle into the innermost position, with its wheels resting in the wheel trays.
3. Secure the bicycle frame using the provided frame holders. Ensure the frame is firmly gripped and cannot move.
4. Use the wheel straps to secure both wheels to the wheel trays.
5. Repeat for the remaining bicycles, alternating direction if necessary to prevent handlebars/pedals from colliding.
6. After loading all bikes, double-check all frame holders and wheel straps for tightness.

2. Unloading Bicycles

Reverse the loading procedure. Release wheel straps, then frame holders, and carefully lift each bicycle off the carrier.

3. Driving with the Carrier

Always drive cautiously when the carrier is loaded. Avoid sudden braking, sharp turns, and high speeds. Periodically check the carrier and bicycle security during long journeys, especially after the first 15 minutes of driving. Be mindful of overhead clearances and increased vehicle length when parking or maneuvering.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the carrier regularly with mild soap and water, especially after exposure to road salt or dirt. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically lubricate moving parts and hinges with a suitable lubricant to ensure smooth operation and prevent corrosion.
- **Inspection:** Before each use, inspect all straps, bolts, and structural components for wear, damage, or corrosion. Replace any worn or damaged parts immediately.
- **Storage:** Store the carrier in a dry, protected area when not in use to prolong its lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Carrier feels loose or wobbles	Straps not tight enough; improper vehicle attachment; damaged components.	Re-tighten all mounting straps evenly. Ensure carrier pads are correctly seated. Inspect for damage and replace parts if necessary.
Bicycles are not secure	Frame holders or wheel straps not tightened; bikes improperly positioned.	Ensure bicycle frames are firmly gripped by holders. Tighten all wheel straps. Re-position bikes to avoid contact.
Vehicle lights/license plate obstructed	Carrier or bikes are blocking visibility.	Adjust bike positions if possible. Consider purchasing and installing an auxiliary light board and license plate holder.
