PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Conair ExtremeSteam Handheld Garment Steamer, Model GS76GD, utilizes advanced steam technology with a 1550-watt steam generator to deliver hotter steam for faster results. Designed for efficiency, it can instantly release wrinkles, refresh upholstery, and provide garments with a professional, fresh-pressed appearance. Its compact design makes it convenient for home use and travel.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the steamer.
- Keep the appliance away from water.
- Do not operate with a damaged cord or plug.
- Always unplug the appliance when filling with water or cleaning.
- Use the steamer only for its intended household use as described in this manual.
- Do not direct steam at people, animals, or directly at electrical outlets. Steam is hot and can cause burns.
- Always ensure the water tank is securely in place before operating.

COMPONENTS AND FEATURES

- **Steam Plate:** Quilted aluminum steamer plate designed to perform like an iron for a fresh-pressed look.
- **Water Tank:** Transparent 7.3 oz capacity water tank for up to 15 minutes of continuous steam.

- **Control Buttons:** Includes a power button, a steam button, and a Turbo button for supercharged steam.
- **3-in-1 Attachment:**
 - **Silicone Band:** Helps pull fabric taut for easier steaming.
 - **Delicate Fabric Spacer:** Provides protection for fragile fabrics and trims.
 - **Bristle Brush:** Loosens fibers to allow steam to penetrate deeper into the fabric.

SETUP

1. **Fill Water Tank:** Ensure the steamer is unplugged. Detach the water tank by lifting it up while pulling it out. Fill the tank with distilled water. Do not overfill. Reinsert the water tank securely until it clicks into place.
2. **Attach Accessories (Optional):** If desired, attach one of the 3-in-1 accessories (silicone band, delicate fabric spacer, or bristle brush) to the steamer head. Ensure it is firmly attached.
3. **Plug In:** Plug the steamer into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Power On:** Press the power button located on the handle. The "Steam" indicator light will begin to blink, indicating the steamer is heating up.
2. **Heat-Up Time:** The steamer heats up in approximately 40 seconds. The "Steam" indicator light will stop blinking and remain solid blue when it is ready to produce steam.
3. **Start Steaming:** Once the "Steam" light is solid, press the "Steam" button to begin steaming. Direct the steam plate towards the fabric you wish to de-wrinkle.
4. **Turbo Mode:** For tougher wrinkles or thicker fabrics, press the "Turbo" button. This will activate a supercharged steam output for enhanced performance.
5. **Steaming Technique:** Hold the fabric taut with one hand and move the steamer slowly over the fabric in a vertical motion. For best results, steam from top to bottom.
6. **Power Off:** When finished, press the power button to turn off the steamer and unplug it from the outlet.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Empty Water Tank:** After each use, ensure the steamer is cool and unplugged. Empty any remaining water from the tank to prevent mineral buildup.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the steamer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Descaling (Monthly):** To maintain optimal performance, descale the steamer monthly, especially in areas with hard water. Fill the water tank with a mixture of 50% white vinegar and 50% water. Run the steamer until half the solution is used, then turn off and let it sit for 30 minutes. Repeat until the tank is empty. Rinse the tank thoroughly with fresh water.
- **Storage:** Store the steamer in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture. Ensure the cord is not tightly wrapped around the unit.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or low steam output.	Water tank is empty or low. Steamer not heated sufficiently. Mineral buildup.	Refill water tank. Allow steamer to fully heat until light is solid. Perform descaling procedure.
Water spitting or leaking.	Overfilled water tank. Steamer not fully heated. Mineral buildup.	Do not overfill the tank. Allow steamer to fully heat. Perform descaling procedure.
Steamer not turning on.	Not plugged in correctly. Power outlet issue.	Ensure plug is fully inserted. Try a different outlet.
