Turtle Beach Stealth 600 Wireless Surround Sound Gaming Headset for Xbox One User Manual

Model: TBS-2015-01

1. INTRODUCTION

The Turtle Beach Stealth 600 is a wireless gaming headset designed for Xbox One and Xbox Series X consoles, featuring Microsoft's Xbox Wireless direct-to-console technology for seamless connection. It also supports Windows Sonic surround sound for an immersive audio experience. This headset incorporates powerful 50mm over-ear speakers and a high-sensitivity flip-up microphone for clear communication.

Key features include Turtle Beach's ProSpecs glasses-friendly design for enhanced comfort, a breathable mesh fabric on the headband and ear cushions, Superhuman Hearing sound setting for tactical awareness, Mic Monitoring, independent game and chat volume control, and audio presets including Bass Boost. The headset is powered by a 15-hour rechargeable battery.

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Charge

Before first use, fully charge your headset using the provided USB charging cable. Connect the micro-USB end to the headset's charging port and the USB-A end to a powered USB port (e.g., on your console, PC, or a USB wall adapter). A full charge provides up to 15 hours of battery life.

3.2 Connecting to Xbox One / Xbox Series X

1. Power on your Xbox console.
2. Press and hold the **Power Button** on the Stealth 600 headset until the LED indicator lights up.
3. Press the **Enroll Button** on your Xbox console (located near the USB ports). The Xbox logo on the console will flash.

4. Press and hold the **Connect Button** on the Stealth 600 headset (located near the charging port) until the headset's LED indicator flashes rapidly.
5. Within a few seconds, the headset and console LEDs will turn solid, indicating a successful connection.

3.3 Connecting to Windows 10 PC

For wireless connection to a Windows 10 PC, an Xbox Wireless Adapter for Windows (sold separately) may be required. Follow the adapter's instructions for installation, then pair the headset using the same steps as for an Xbox console.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Headset Controls

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to power on/off.
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through audio presets (e.g., Signature Sound, Bass Boost, Bass & Treble Boost, Vocal Boost).
- **Game Volume Dial:** Adjusts the overall game audio volume.
- **Chat Volume Dial:** Adjusts the chat audio volume independently.
- **Flip-Up Microphone:** Flip down to activate the microphone for chat. Flip up to mute the microphone.

4.2 Superhuman Hearing

The Superhuman Hearing setting enhances subtle in-game sounds like enemy footsteps and weapon reloads, providing a competitive advantage. Activate this feature via the Mode button or dedicated button (if available on your model) to toggle it on or off.

4.3 Mic Monitoring

Mic Monitoring allows you to hear your own voice through the headset, preventing you from shouting during intense gaming sessions. This feature is automatically active when the microphone is down.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the headset with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- For ear cushions, gently wipe with a damp cloth and allow to air dry completely.

5.2 Storage

Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on the headset to prevent damage.

5.3 Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the headset frequently. Charge the headset regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 No Audio / Intermittent Audio

- Ensure the headset is fully charged and powered on.
- Verify the headset is properly paired with your Xbox console or PC. Re-pair if necessary.
- Check the game and chat volume dials on the headset to ensure they are not set to minimum.
- Confirm that the headset is selected as the audio output device in your console or PC settings.
- Move closer to your console/PC to rule out range issues or interference.

6.2 Microphone Not Working

- Ensure the microphone is flipped down to activate it.
- Check the chat volume dial to ensure it is not muted or set too low.
- Verify microphone settings on your console or PC.
- Test the microphone with another application or game to isolate the issue.

6.3 Headset Not Charging

- Ensure the USB charging cable is securely connected to both the headset and the power source.
- Try a different USB port or charging adapter.
- Confirm the power source is active.

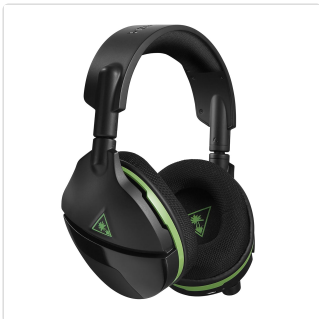


Figure 3: Close-up of the breathable mesh fabric ear cushions for comfort.

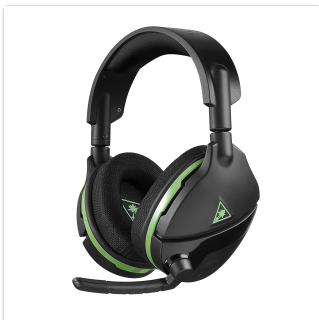


Figure 4: The high-sensitivity flip-up microphone in the down position.

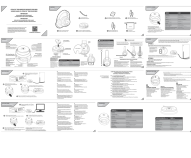
