# Akai AKTV3213TS 32-inch HD LED TV Instruction Manual

Model: AKTV3213TS

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Akai AKTV3213TS 32-inch HD LED TV. Please read these instructions thoroughly before using the television and retain them for future reference.

The Akai AKTV3213TS is a 32-inch HD Ready LED television featuring integrated DVB-T2 (terrestrial) and DVB-S2 (satellite) tuners, allowing reception of digital broadcasts. It offers a resolution of 1366 x 768 pixels, a 16:9 aspect ratio, and multiple connectivity options for various external devices.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Observe the following safety precautions to prevent fire, electric shock, or injury:

- **Power Source:** Connect the TV only to an AC power outlet of the specified voltage.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the TV. Do not block ventilation openings.
- **Water and Moisture:** Do not expose the TV to rain or moisture. Do not place objects filled with liquids, such as vases, on the TV.
- **Heat:** Keep the TV away from heat sources like radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus that produce heat.
- **Cleaning:** Unplug the TV from the wall outlet before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners.
- **Servicing:** Do not attempt to service this product yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.
- **Mounting:** When mounting the TV on a wall, follow the manufacturer's instructions for the wall mount.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the packaging:

- Akai AKTV3213TS 32-inch HD LED TV
- Remote Control
- Power Cable
- TV Stand (if applicable)
- User Manual (this document)
- Cables (as specified by manufacturer)

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## 4. SETUP

### 4.1. Attaching the TV Stand

1. Carefully place the TV face-down on a soft, flat surface to prevent screen damage.
2. Align the stand components with the mounting holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stand using the provided screws. Ensure the stand is firmly attached before proceeding.

### 4.2. Connecting External Devices

Your Akai AKTV3213TS TV offers various connection ports:

- **Antenna/Cable (RF):** Connect your terrestrial antenna or cable TV signal to the RF input.
- **Satellite (DVB-S2):** Connect your satellite dish cable to the DVB-S2 input for satellite broadcasts.
- **HDMI:** Use HDMI cables to connect high-definition devices such as Blu-ray players, game consoles, or set-top boxes to the HDMI ports (x3).
- **SCART:** Connect older devices like VCRs or DVD players using a SCART cable.
- **USB:** Insert a USB drive into the USB port (x1) to play multimedia content.
- **VGA:** Connect a computer to the VGA port (x1) for use as a monitor.
- **PC Audio In:** If using VGA, connect an audio cable from your PC to the PC Audio In port.
- **Headphone:** Connect headphones for private listening.
- **CI+ Slot:** Insert a Conditional Access Module (CAM) and smart card for encrypted digital services.

### 4.3. Power Connection

After connecting all necessary cables, plug the power cable into the TV's power input and then into a wall outlet.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1. Power On/Off

Press the power button on the remote control or on the TV to turn the television on or off.

### 5.2. Initial Setup Wizard

Upon first power-on, the TV will guide you through an initial setup process. This typically includes:

- Language selection.
- Country selection.
- Automatic channel scanning for DVB-T2 and DVB-S2 broadcasts.

### 5.3. Channel Tuning

If channels were not found during initial setup or if you wish to rescan, navigate to the 'Settings' or 'Channel' menu and select 'Auto Scan' or 'Manual Scan' for DVB-T2 (Terrestrial) or DVB-S2 (Satellite) channels.

### 5.4. Input Source Selection

Press the 'Source' or 'Input' button on your remote control to cycle through available input sources (HDMI 1, HDMI 2, HDMI 3, SCART, AV, PC, USB, DVB-T2, DVB-S2).

### 5.5. Volume Control

Use the 'Volume Up' and 'Volume Down' buttons on the remote control to adjust the audio level.

### 5.6. Teletext Function

The TV supports Teletext. Press the 'TEXT' button on your remote control to access Teletext services, if available on the current broadcast channel.

## 5.7. Hotel Function

This TV includes a Hotel Function, which allows for specific settings to be locked or customized for use in hospitality environments. Refer to the advanced settings menu for configuration options, typically requiring a password.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

### 6.1. Cleaning the Screen

Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a specialized screen cleaner (ensure it is suitable for LED screens) and wipe carefully. Do not apply pressure or use abrasive materials.

### 6.2. Cleaning the Cabinet

Wipe the TV cabinet with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using strong detergents or solvents as they may damage the finish.

### 6.3. Power Cord Care

Regularly check the power cord for any damage. If damaged, have it replaced by qualified service personnel.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, consult the following common solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cable is securely plugged into the TV and the wall outlet. Check if the wall outlet is functioning.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, antenna, etc.).
- **Poor Picture Quality:** Check antenna or satellite signal strength. Ensure cables are not damaged. Adjust picture settings in the TV menu.
- **Remote Control Not Working:** Check the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
- **No Channels Found:** Perform an automatic channel scan. Ensure your antenna or satellite dish is correctly installed and aligned.


