Minuteman Front Squeegee (Model 172282) Instruction Manual

- **Floor Contact:** The squeegee blades must maintain consistent contact with the floor surface across their entire length to ensure complete water removal.
- **Machine Speed:** Operate the cleaning machine at a speed that allows the squeegee to effectively collect all dispensed water and solution. Excessive speed can lead to streaking or incomplete drying.
- **Solution Compatibility:** Use cleaning solutions recommended by the manufacturer of your Minuteman cleaning equipment. Incompatible solutions can degrade squeegee blade material over time.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your Minuteman Front Squeegee (Model 172282) will extend its lifespan and ensure optimal cleaning performance.

4.1 Daily Maintenance

- **Clean Blades:** After each use, wipe down the squeegee blades with a clean cloth to remove any dirt, debris, or chemical residue.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with water recovery or streaking, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

- **Poor Water Pickup / Streaking:**
 - **Cause:** Worn, damaged, or improperly adjusted squeegee blades.
 - **Solution:** Inspect blades for wear or damage. Rotate or replace if necessary. Adjust squeegee assembly to ensure even floor contact.
 - **Cause:** Debris caught under the squeegee.
 - **Solution:** Clean the squeegee blades and assembly thoroughly.
 - **Cause:** Vacuum system issues (e.g., clogged hose, full recovery tank, faulty vacuum motor).
 - **Solution:** Check the vacuum hose for obstructions, empty the recovery tank, and ensure the vacuum motor is functioning correctly. Refer to your machine's main manual for vacuum system troubleshooting.
- **Squeegee Leaves Excessive Water:**
 - **Cause:** Incorrect squeegee angle or pressure.
 - **Solution:** Adjust the squeegee assembly to achieve the correct angle and pressure for optimal water removal.
 - **Cause:** Machine operating too fast.
 - **Solution:** Reduce the operating speed of the cleaning equipment.
