## INTRODUCTION

The Sphero BB-9E is a menacing astromech droid of the First Order, designed for interactive control via a smart device. This app-enabled droid offers an immersive experience within the Star Wars galaxy, allowing users to control its movements, engage in holographic simulations with the Droid Trainer, and observe its interactions with other Sphero Star Wars App-enabled Droids. BB-9E also features signature LED lights in its dome and can react while viewing films from the Star Wars saga.

## SETUP GUIDE

### 1. Charging Your BB-9E Droid

Before first use, ensure your BB-9E Droid is fully charged. Place the BB-9E Droid onto its inductive charging base. Connect the USB charging cable from the base to a compatible USB power source. The droid's indicator lights will show charging status. A full charge typically takes approximately 3 hours.

## 2. Downloading and Connecting the App

To control your BB-9E, you will need to download the Sphero App. Search for "Sphero App" in your device's app store (iOS or Android). Once installed, open the app and follow the on-screen instructions to connect to your BB-9E Droid via Bluetooth. Ensure your device's Bluetooth is enabled.

### Authentic Movement

Control BB-9E's movements directly from your smart device. The app provides intuitive controls to drive the droid, allowing it to roll and move authentically, mimicking its on-screen counterpart.

### Holographic Simulation with Droid Trainer

Place BB-9E on its Droid Trainer accessory. Use the app to explore the Star Wars galaxy through augmented reality. The Droid Trainer enhances the interactive experience by projecting holographic simulations.

View films from the Star Wars saga with BB-9E by your side. The droid will react to key moments in the movies, enhancing your viewing experience with its movements and sounds.

### **Signature LEDs**

BB-9E's dome is equipped with vibrant LED lights that illuminate during operation and interactions, adding to its authentic appearance.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### Cleaning

To clean your BB-9E, gently wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the droid's finish. Ensure no moisture enters the charging port or any seams.

### Storage

When not in use, store your BB-9E Droid in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. It is recommended to store the droid on its charging base to maintain battery health, or ensure it has a partial charge if storing for extended periods.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### App Connectivity Issues

If you experience difficulty connecting your BB-9E to the app:

- Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your smart device.
- Make sure the BB-9E Droid is charged and powered on.
- Restart the Sphero App and try connecting again.
- If the issue persists, try restarting your smart device.
- Verify that you are using the correct and most up-to-date Sphero App. Some older versions of the app may no longer support the BB-9E Droid.

## Charging Problems

If your BB-9E Droid is not charging:

- Check that the USB charging cable is securely connected to both the inductive base and the power source.
- Try using a different USB port or power adapter.
- Ensure the droid is correctly seated on the inductive charging base.
- If the battery does not hold a charge, it may indicate a battery issue.
