INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your THOR Kitchen Freestanding Professional 30-Inch Gas Range, Model LRG3001U. Please read all instructions thoroughly before using the appliance to ensure proper function and to prevent potential hazards. Retain this manual for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using this appliance to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.

- Ensure proper installation and grounding by a qualified installer.
- Do not store flammable materials in or near the appliance.
- · Never use the appliance for space heating.
- Keep children away from the appliance during operation.
- Do not repair or replace any part of the appliance unless specifically recommended in this manual. All other servicing should be referred to a qualified technician.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials, tape, and protective film from the range. Inspect the appliance for any shipping damage. Report any damage immediately to the retailer.

2. Placement and Leveling

The THOR Kitchen LRG3001U is a freestanding unit. Ensure adequate clearance from combustible materials. The appliance dimensions are approximately 30 x 29 x 38 inches (Width x Depth x Height). Use the adjustable leveling

legs at the bottom of the range to ensure the unit is stable and level. Proper leveling is crucial for even cooking and safe operation.

3. Gas Connection

This appliance operates on natural gas. Conversion kits for LP gas may be available; consult a qualified technician for conversion. The gas supply line must be connected by a qualified and licensed technician in accordance with local codes and regulations. Ensure the gas shut-off valve is accessible after installation.

4. Electrical Connection

The range requires a 120 Volt electrical supply. Ensure the electrical outlet is properly grounded and installed by a qualified electrician. Do not use extension cords with this appliance.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Control Panel Overview

The control panel features multiple knobs for burner and oven control, along with a light switch and a convection fan switch.

2. Surface Burner Operation

The cooktop features sealed burners with varying BTU outputs, including a high-powered 18,000 BTU burner for rapid heating. The continuous grates allow for easy movement of cookware.

- 1. Place cookware on the grate over the desired burner.
- 2. Push in and turn the corresponding burner knob counter-clockwise to the "HIGH" position.
- 3. The igniter will click, and the burner will light. Once lit, release the knob.
- 4. Adjust the flame size by turning the knob between "HIGH" and "LOW" settings.
- 5. To turn off, turn the knob clockwise to the "OFF" position.

3. Oven Operation

The oven has a 4.55 cu. ft. capacity and features a commercial convection fan for even heat distribution.

- **Baking:** Turn the oven control knob to the desired temperature. The oven will preheat. The convection fan can be activated for faster and more even cooking by flipping the "Convection Fan" switch.
- **Broiling:** Turn the oven control knob to the "BROIL" setting. The reflective gas tube broiler distributes heat evenly for searing.
- Oven Light: Use the "Light" switch on the control panel to illuminate the oven interior.

4. Storage Drawer

The storage drawer located beneath the oven provides additional space for storing cooking trays, bakeware, or other kitchen utensils.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Cooktop

- Allow the cooktop to cool completely before cleaning.
- Remove grates and burner caps. Wash with warm, soapy water.
- Wipe the stainless steel surface with a damp cloth and a mild detergent. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive stainless steel cleaner.

• Ensure all parts are dry before reassembling.

2. Cleaning the Oven Interior

- Remove oven racks. Clean with warm, soapy water or an oven cleaner suitable for gas ovens.
- Wipe the interior surfaces with a damp cloth. Avoid harsh abrasives.

3. Oven Igniter Maintenance

If the oven fails to ignite, the igniter may need inspection or replacement. This is a common maintenance item for gas ranges. Consult a qualified service technician for diagnosis and replacement. Generic igniters with an amperage range of 3.3 to 3.6 are typically compatible.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Before contacting customer service, review the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner does not ignite or ignites slowly.	Igniter is dirty or wet; gas supply issue; burner cap not seated correctly.	Clean igniter and burner cap. Ensure burner cap is properly seated. Verify gas supply is on. Hold knob for 10-30 seconds to allow gas to flow and igniter to warm.
Oven does not heat.	Gas supply off; igniter failure; incorrect temperature setting.	Check gas supply. Ensure oven knob is set to a temperature. If igniter is not glowing, it may need replacement by a qualified technician.
Uneven cooking in oven.	Oven not level; improper rack placement; convection fan off.	Ensure the range is level. Use appropriate rack positions. Activate the convection fan for more even heat distribution.
