# Skywin VR Cable Management System

Instruction Manual for Oculus Rift, HTC Vive, and Playstation VR Headsets

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Skywin VR Cable Management System is designed to provide an unobstructed virtual reality experience by keeping your headset cable clear of your play area. This system utilizes retractable lines and adhesive hooks for a drill-free installation, allowing for free movement during VR gameplay.

### Package Contents:

- 8 x Retractable Cable Management Units
- 8 x Adhesive Hooks
- 8 x Carabiners
- 1 x Adjusting Tool

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for a quick and easy, drill-free installation of your VR Cable Management System.

1. **Plan Your Layout:** Determine the optimal placement for each retractable unit on your ceiling. Consider your VR play area and the path your headset cable will take to avoid snags. A common setup involves placing units in a curve or line above the center of your play space.
2. **Prepare the Surface:** Ensure the ceiling surface where you plan to attach the adhesive hooks is clean, dry, and free of dust or grease.
3. **Attach Adhesive Hooks:** Peel the backing from an adhesive hook and firmly press it onto the chosen ceiling spot. Hold for at least 30 seconds to ensure strong adhesion. Repeat for all 8 hooks, spacing them appropriately for your desired cable path. Allow the adhesive to cure for a few hours before hanging any weight.

4. **Attach Retractable Units:** Connect one retractable cable management unit to each adhesive hook using the small loop on the unit.
5. **Connect VR Cable:** Attach your VR headset cable to the carabiners on the retractable units. Start from the unit closest to your headset's connection point (e.g., PC) and work your way towards the headset. Ensure there is enough slack for comfortable movement without excessive tension on the cable or the retractable units.
6. **Adjust Cable Length:** Use the provided adjusting tool to fine-tune the tension and retraction length of each unit. The goal is to keep the cable overhead and out of the way, but loose enough to prevent resistance during gameplay.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Once installed, the Skywin VR Cable Management System operates automatically to keep your VR headset cable elevated and out of your way.

- The retractable units will extend and retract as you move within your VR play space, maintaining appropriate tension on the cable.
- Ensure the cable moves smoothly through each carabiner and that no units are snagging or getting stuck.
- Periodically check that the cable has sufficient slack to prevent pulling on your headset or the connection port.

## MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Skywin VR Cable Management System, consider the following maintenance tips:

- **Check Adhesion:** Periodically inspect the adhesive hooks on your ceiling to ensure they remain firmly attached. If an adhesive pad shows signs of peeling, re-secure it or replace it if necessary.
- **Inspect Retractable Units:** Check the retractable mechanisms for smooth operation. Ensure the internal spring allows for full extension and retraction without resistance.
- **Clean Components:** If dust or debris accumulates on the units or carabiners, gently wipe them with a dry or slightly damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals.
- **Cable Condition:** Regularly inspect your VR headset cable for any signs of wear, fraying, or damage, especially at points where it connects to the carabiners.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Skywin VR Cable Management System, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Cable Snagging or Excessive Tension:**

- **Solution:** Re-evaluate the placement of your retractable units. They may be too far apart or not aligned correctly with your primary movement patterns. Adjust the position of the adhesive hooks or the tension of individual retractable units using the adjusting tool. Ensure the cable is not twisted.

- **Adhesive Hooks Losing Grip:**

- **Solution:** Ensure the surface was clean and dry before initial application. For textured or uneven surfaces, adhesive may not hold as effectively. Consider using alternative mounting methods if the adhesive consistently fails, such as small screw-in hooks (not included) if your ceiling material allows.

- **Retractable Unit Not Fully Retracting:**

- **Solution:** Check if the cable is tangled within the carabiner or if there's any obstruction. Ensure the spring mechanism is not damaged. If a unit is faulty, it may need replacement.

- **Difficulty Attaching Cable to Last Carabiner (Square Box Design):**

- **Solution:** If the last unit's design makes direct attachment difficult, consider using a small keyring or a similar sturdy loop to bridge the connection between the unit and the VR cable. Additionally, taping the VR cable to the last carabiner can prevent the cable from pulling through, allowing the retractable mechanism to manage the slack effectively.
