1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Orbegozo VT 810 8-Bottle Wine Cooler. This appliance is designed to store and cool your wine bottles at an optimal temperature, ensuring their preservation and readiness for consumption. Please read this manual carefully before operating the wine cooler to ensure proper use, maintenance, and safety.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, follow these basic precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the rating label matches your household voltage.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstructions.
- This appliance is for household use only.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or when not in use for extended periods.
- Do not allow children to play with or operate the appliance.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present upon unpacking:

- Orbegozo VT 810 Wine Cooler unit
- 3 Chromed removable shelves
- Instruction Manual

4. SETUP

4.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Keep packaging for future transport or disposal. Ensure no parts are missing or damaged. If any damage is observed, do not operate the appliance and contact customer service.

4.2 Placement

- Place the wine cooler on a firm, level surface to prevent vibrations and ensure proper operation.
- Allow at least 10 cm (4 inches) of space around the back and sides for adequate ventilation.
- Avoid placing the unit in direct sunlight or near heat sources (e.g., ovens, radiators).
- Do not install in areas with high humidity.

4.3 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, clean the interior and exterior of the wine cooler with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly.

4.4 Power Connection

Plug the appliance into a grounded electrical outlet. Allow the unit to stand upright for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it in to allow the refrigerant to settle.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Control Panel

The wine cooler features a touch control panel and a digital display for easy temperature management and lighting control.

- **Temperature Adjustment:** Use the **Up** and **Down** arrows on the touch panel to set the desired temperature. The temperature range is between 11°C and 18°C (52°F and 64°F). The digital display will show the current internal temperature.
- **LED Light Control:** Press the **Light** icon to turn the interior LED light on or off. This low-consumption LED light illuminates the contents without affecting the internal temperature.
- **Temperature Unit:** Press the **°C/°F** icon to switch between Celsius and Fahrenheit display.

5.2 Loading Bottles

The wine cooler is designed to hold up to 8 standard wine bottles. Arrange bottles on the chromed removable shelves. Ensure bottles are placed securely to prevent rolling.

5.3 Auto-Defrost Function

The appliance features an automatic defrost function, which helps maintain optimal operating conditions and reduces the need for manual defrosting.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Interior

Unplug the unit before cleaning. Use a soft cloth dampened with a mild detergent solution to clean the interior surfaces. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Dry thoroughly before plugging the unit back in.

6.2 Cleaning the Exterior

Clean the exterior with a soft cloth and mild detergent. For the glass door, use a glass cleaner. Ensure no water enters the

control panel or electrical components.

6.3 Shelf Care

The chromed shelves can be removed for cleaning. Wash them with warm soapy water, rinse, and dry completely before returning them to the unit.

6.4 Long-Term Storage

If the wine cooler will not be used for an extended period, unplug it, clean it thoroughly, and leave the door slightly ajar to prevent odors and mold growth.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wine cooler does not operate	No power supply.	Check if the power plug is properly inserted into the outlet. Check the fuse or circuit breaker.
Temperature is not cold enough	Door not closed properly. Too many door openings. Ambient temperature too high. Unit placed near a heat source.	Ensure the door is fully closed. Reduce frequency of door openings. Move the unit to a cooler location. Ensure proper ventilation.
Excessive noise	Unit not level. Vibrations from bottles.	Adjust leveling feet to ensure the unit is stable. Rearrange bottles to prevent contact.
Digital display not working	Power issue. Control panel malfunction.	Check power supply. If problem persists, contact customer service.
