CYBEX Silver Solution M-Fix SL Car Seat Instruction Manual

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Never leave your child unattended in the vehicle.

This car seat is designed for children aged approximately 3 to 12 years, weighing between 15-36 kg (Group 2/3). Always read and understand all instructions before use to ensure maximum safety and proper installation. The CYBEX Solution M-Fix SL car seat features integrated Linear Side-impact Protection (L.S.P. System) and an energy-absorbing shell for enhanced safety.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The CYBEX Solution M-Fix SL is a high-quality child car seat designed for durability and comfort. It can be installed in vehicles with or without ISOFIX anchorage points.

- **Adjustable Headrest:** Features 12 height positions for optimal fit as your child grows.
- **Adjustable Recline Backrest:** Allows for a comfortable sleeping position.
- **Optimized Air Circulation System:** Ensures comfort during longer journeys.
- **Removable and Washable Cover:** The cover is 100% polyester and can be machine washed at 30°C.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Preparing the Car Seat

Before installation, ensure the car seat is in good condition and free from any damage. The headrest should be adjusted to the lowest position initially.

2. Installation with ISOFIX Connect System

1. Locate the ISOFIX anchorage points in your vehicle. These are usually found between the seat back and seat cushion.
2. Extend the ISOFIX Connect latches from the car seat by pressing the release buttons (if applicable) and pulling them out.
3. Align the ISOFIX Connect latches with the vehicle's ISOFIX anchorage points and push the car seat firmly until the latches click into place. Green indicators should appear on both sides, confirming correct installation.
4. Push the car seat firmly against the vehicle's backrest to ensure a secure fit.

3. Installation with Vehicle Seat Belt (without ISOFIX)

1. Place the car seat on the vehicle's seat.
2. Guide the vehicle's 3-point seat belt through the red belt guides on the car seat. Ensure the lap belt is positioned low across the child's pelvis and the shoulder belt crosses the child's shoulder and chest.
3. Buckle the seat belt and pull it tight to remove any slack.
4. Double-check that the seat belt is not twisted and is securely routed through all designated guides.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Securing Your Child

Once the car seat is installed, place your child in the seat. Guide the vehicle's 3-point seat belt across your child and through the red belt guides on the car seat. Ensure the belt is snug but not too tight, and that it lies flat against your child's body without any twists.

2. Adjusting the Headrest

The headrest should be adjusted so that there are no more than two fingers' width between the child's shoulders and the bottom of the headrest. To adjust, squeeze the headrest adjustment handle (usually located at the back or

top of the headrest) and slide the headrest up or down to the desired position. Release the handle to lock it in place.

3. Adjusting the Recline Position

The backrest can be slightly reclined for your child's comfort, especially during sleep. Consult your vehicle's manual for compatibility with reclined car seats. To recline, typically there is a lever or button at the base of the seat or near the backrest connection.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Cleaning the Car Seat Cover

The fabric cover of the CYBEX Solution M-Fix SL car seat is removable and machine-washable. Follow these steps:

1. Carefully remove the fabric cover from the car seat frame.
2. Machine wash the cover at 30°C (86°F) on a delicate cycle. Do not tumble dry, bleach, or iron.

3. Allow the cover to air dry completely before reattaching it to the car seat.

Cleaning the Car Seat Frame

The plastic parts of the car seat can be cleaned with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh cleaning agents or solvents.

Storage

When not in use, store the car seat in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. Do not place heavy objects on top of the car seat.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car seat feels loose after installation.	ISOFIX latches not fully engaged or seat belt not tightened sufficiently.	Ensure ISOFIX green indicators are visible. If using seat belt, pull belt firmly to remove all slack. Push down on the car seat while tightening.
Headrest is difficult to adjust.	Adjustment mechanism might be stiff or obstructed.	Ensure the adjustment handle is fully squeezed. Check for any obstructions. Apply gentle, even pressure.
Child's head slumps forward when sleeping.	Headrest not adjusted correctly or recline not utilized.	Adjust the headrest to the correct height. Utilize the recline function if available and compatible with your vehicle.
