1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Fluval Roma 125L Aquarium Table is a dedicated support cabinet designed for the Fluval Roma 125L aquarium. This black, freestanding unit provides a stable and aesthetically pleasing base for your aquarium, incorporating storage space within its design. It is constructed from wood and features two doors for convenient access to internal compartments.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety instructions before assembling and using the Fluval Roma 125L Aquarium Table.

- **Secure the Aquarium:** Always secure the aquarium to the table to prevent accidental tipping. This is crucial for safety, especially considering the significant weight of a filled aquarium.
- **Weight Capacity:** The table is designed to support the Fluval Roma 125L aquarium. When full, the aquarium weighs approximately 24.34 kg (53.5 pounds) plus the weight of water and fish. Ensure the table is placed on a level, sturdy surface capable of supporting this combined weight.
- **Electrical Safety:** If your aquarium setup includes an LCD thermometer or other electrical components, exercise caution when handling them to avoid electrical shock. Ensure all electrical connections are dry and properly insulated.
- **Assembly:** Assembly is required. Follow all provided assembly instructions carefully. If no instructions are included, contact Fluval customer support for guidance.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area and the aquarium setup to prevent injury or damage.

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Unpacking and Parts Identification

1. Carefully unpack all components from the packaging.
2. Verify that all parts listed in the assembly guide (if provided) are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

3.2 Assembly

The Fluval Roma 125L Aquarium Table requires assembly. Please refer to the detailed assembly instructions and diagrams included with your product for step-by-step guidance. If no assembly instructions were provided, please contact Fluval customer support for assistance.

General Assembly Tips:

- Assemble the unit on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratching.
- Ensure all screws and fasteners are tightened securely, but do not overtighten.
- Verify the stability of the assembled table before placing the aquarium on it.

3.3 Placement and Securing

1. Choose a permanent, level location for the aquarium table, away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and drafts. Ensure the floor can support the total weight of the filled aquarium and table.
2. Carefully place the Fluval Roma 125L aquarium onto the assembled table. Ensure it is centered and stable.
3. Follow the instructions provided with your Fluval Roma 125L aquarium for securing it to the table to prevent tipping. This may involve using brackets or other fastening mechanisms.

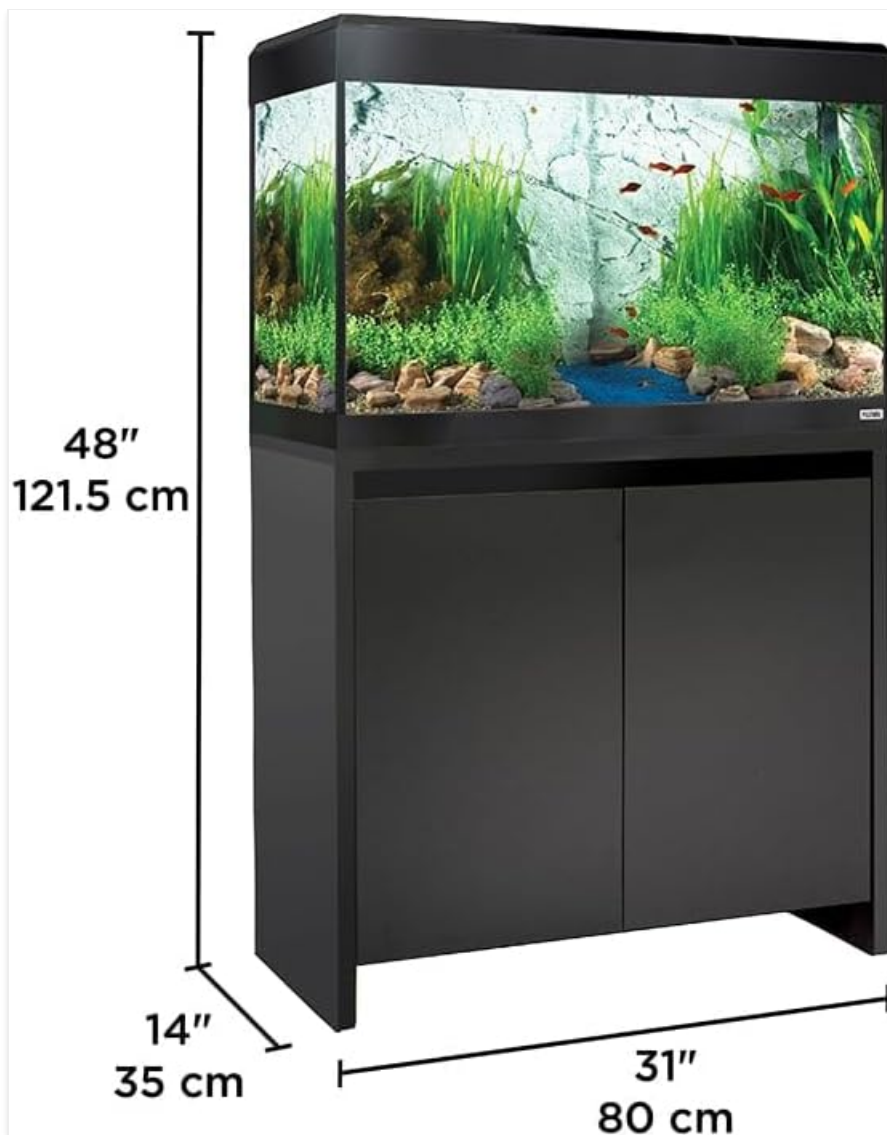


Figure 2: Fluval Roma 125L Aquarium Table with dimensions. This image illustrates the Fluval Roma 125L Aquarium Table with an aquarium placed on its top surface. Overlaid dimensions indicate the table's length (80 cm / 31 inches), width (35 cm / 14 inches), and total height with the aquarium (121.5 cm / 48 inches).

4. OPERATION

The Fluval Roma 125L Aquarium Table functions as a stable support structure for your aquarium. Once assembled and the aquarium is securely placed, its primary operation involves providing a safe and level base.

- **Storage:** Utilize the internal compartments behind the doors for storing aquarium supplies, food, or cleaning tools. Ensure items are stored neatly and do not obstruct the doors.
- **Stability Check:** Periodically check the table's stability and ensure the aquarium remains securely seated on its surface.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and integrity of your Fluval Roma 125L Aquarium Table.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Immediately wipe up any water spills from the aquarium to prevent water damage to the table's wood material.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all assembly fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.

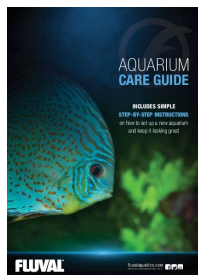
