PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP

Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your Veho ZB-6 headphones. A full charge provides up to 24 hours of continuous music playback.

1. Connect the Micro USB end of the charging cable to the charging port on the headphone earcup.
2. Connect the USB-A end of the charging cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter).
3. The LED indicator on the headphones will illuminate during charging and change color or turn off when fully charged.

Bluetooth Pairing

Pair your Veho ZB-6 headphones with your Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, PC, MP3 player).

1. Ensure the headphones are turned off.
2. Press and hold the Power button on the earcup for approximately 6 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue and red alternately. This indicates the headphones are in pairing mode.
3. On your device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "Veho ZB-6" from the list of found devices.
5. Once paired, the LED indicator on the headphones will flash blue slowly, and you will hear a confirmation tone.
6. The headphones will automatically connect to the last paired device when turned on, if it is within range.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Controls

- **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds.
- **Play/Pause:** Press the Play/Pause button once.
- **Volume Up:** Press the Volume Up (+) button.
- **Volume Down:** Press the Volume Down (-) button.
- **Next Track:** Press and hold the Volume Up (+) button.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the Volume Down (-) button.

Call Management

The built-in microphone allows for hands-free calling.

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Play/Pause button once during an incoming call or an active call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Play/Pause button for 2 seconds during an incoming call.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the Play/Pause button.

Voice Commands (Siri/Google Now)

The Veho ZB-6 headphones support voice commands for compatible devices.

- **Activate Voice Assistant:** Press the Play/Pause button twice quickly.

Auxiliary Mode

Use the included 3.5mm auxiliary cable to connect the headphones to devices without Bluetooth connectivity, or when the headphone battery is depleted.

- Connect one end of the 3.5mm auxiliary cable to the headphone's AUX port.
- Connect the other end to the audio output jack of your device.
- In auxiliary mode, the headphone's power and Bluetooth functions are disabled, and audio is transmitted directly via the cable.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the headphones with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headphones in a cool, dry place. The folding design allows for compact storage.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Do not expose the headphones to water or excessive moisture.
- **Temperature:** Avoid extreme temperatures, as this can affect battery life and overall performance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Ensure the headphones are fully charged. Connect to a power source using the supplied USB cable.
Cannot pair with device.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing blue and red). • Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. • Move headphones closer to the device. • Forget "Veho ZB-6" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.
No sound or low volume.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase volume on both headphones and connected device. • Ensure headphones are properly paired. • If using auxiliary cable, ensure it is fully inserted and not damaged.
Sound distortion.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move closer to the connected device to avoid interference. • Reduce volume if it's too high. • Try playing different audio sources.
