1. INTRODUCTION

3. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into the computer's power input, then plug the other end into a grounded electrical outlet.

4. **Initial Power On:** Press the power button on the front of the computer. The system will boot up.

5. **Windows 10 Pro Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup of Windows 10 Pro. This may include setting up user accounts, network connections, and basic preferences.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off and Restart:

- **To Power On:** Press the power button on the front panel.
- **To Shut Down:** Click the Start button in Windows, then select Power > Shut down.
- **To Restart:** Click the Start button in Windows, then select Power > Restart.

Connecting to a Network:

- **Wired Connection:** If an Ethernet cable is connected, Windows 10 Pro should automatically detect and connect to the network.
- **Wireless Connection:** If using a USB wireless adapter, ensure it is properly installed. In Windows, click the network icon in the taskbar, select your Wi-Fi network, and enter the password.

Using the Optical Drive:

Press the eject button on the optical drive to open the tray. Place a CD or DVD onto the tray, ensuring it is seated correctly, then gently push the tray back in. Windows will typically auto-run the disc or prompt you for action.

USB Ports:

The computer features both USB 2.0 and USB 3.0 ports. USB 3.0 ports (often blue) offer faster data transfer speeds for compatible devices.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the computer. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid harsh chemicals. Use compressed air to clear dust from vents periodically.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install Windows updates to ensure system security and performance. Go to Start > Settings > Update & Security > Windows Update.
- **Data Backup:** Periodically back up important data to an external drive or cloud storage to prevent data loss.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the computer's vents are clear of obstructions to maintain proper cooling and prevent overheating.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter.

No Power:

- Ensure the power cord is securely connected to both the computer and the electrical outlet.
- Verify the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.

No Display on Monitor:

- Check that the monitor is powered on and its video cable is securely connected to both the monitor and the computer.
- Ensure the correct input source is selected on your monitor.

Slow Performance:

- Close unnecessary programs running in the background.
- Ensure Windows is up to date.
- Check for malware or viruses using reputable antivirus software.
- Ensure adequate free space on the SSD.

Network Connectivity Issues:

- For wired connections, check the Ethernet cable and router/modem status.
- For wireless connections, ensure the USB wireless adapter is properly installed and drivers are up to date. Verify Wi-Fi is enabled and you are connected to the correct network.
