1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Two-Person Assembly:** It is highly recommended that two adults assemble this bed frame to prevent injury and ensure proper construction.
- **Weight Limit:** The bed frame supports a maximum weight of 600 lbs. Do not exceed this limit.
- **Cleaning:** Use a dry cloth for cleaning. A damp cloth may be used sparingly; avoid excessive moisture to prevent damage to the laminated surfaces.
- **Component Check:** Before assembly, verify all parts are present and undamaged. Do not proceed with assembly if any parts are missing or broken.
- **Secure Fasteners:** Ensure all screws and fasteners are tightened securely during assembly and periodically check for tightness during use.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Carefully unpack all components and hardware. Refer to the included parts list in your product packaging to ensure all items are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact Ameriwood Home customer support.

Typical components include:

- Side Rails
- End Rails
- Center Support Beam
- Wooden Slats
- Hardware (screws, cam locks, dowels, etc.)

Tools Required (not included): Phillips head screwdriver, hammer (optional).

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Ameriwood Home Full Platform Bed Frame requires assembly. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included with your unit. Below are general guidelines and a helpful video.

General Assembly Steps:

1. Lay out all parts on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
2. Attach the side rails to the end rails using the provided hardware.
3. Install the center support beam, ensuring it is properly aligned.
4. Place the wooden slats across the frame, securing them according to the instructions. The slats provide crucial support and air circulation for your mattress.
5. Ensure all connections are tight and stable before placing a mattress on the frame.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Ameriwood Home Full Platform Bed Frame is designed to provide a stable and supportive base for your mattress without the need for a box spring.

- **Mattress Placement:** Place your full-sized mattress directly onto the wooden slats. The frame is designed to embed your mattress slightly, preventing it from sliding.
- **No Box Spring Needed:** The integrated wooden slats provide sufficient support and air circulation, eliminating the need for a traditional box spring.
- **Low Profile Design:** The bed frame features a low profile, making it easy to get in and out of bed.
- **Headboard Compatibility:** This platform bed frame is designed to be used with or without a separate headboard. If you wish to attach a headboard, ensure it is compatible with standard full-size bed frames. (Note: Headboard is sold separately).

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will help maintain the appearance and longevity of your bed frame.

- **Cleaning:** Dust and wipe the surfaces with a dry, soft cloth regularly. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth may be used sparingly, followed immediately by a dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain stability.
- **Avoid Excessive Moisture:** Do not expose the bed frame to excessive moisture or humidity, as this can damage the laminated particleboard and MDF.
- **Relocation:** If moving the bed frame, disassemble it carefully to prevent damage. Do not drag the assembled frame, as this can compromise its structural integrity.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your bed frame, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed frame feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose fasteners.	Check and tighten all screws and bolts. Ensure all cam locks are fully engaged.
Parts do not align during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts or manufacturing variation.	Double-check the assembly instructions for correct part orientation. If parts still do not align, contact customer support.
Squeaking noises.	Loose connections or friction between components.	Tighten all fasteners. If squeaking persists, apply a small amount of lubricant (e.g., paraffin wax) to contact points between slats and frame.
Damage to laminate surface.	Impact during shipping or assembly.	For minor damage, touch-up pens or furniture repair kits may be used. For significant damage, contact customer support for replacement parts.
