1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This document provides instructions for the Ariete permanent steel filter disk, designed for use with compatible Ariete espresso machines. This filter disk is a durable, reusable component intended to replace disposable filters, contributing to consistent coffee quality and reduced waste.

2. COMPATIBILITY

The Ariete permanent steel filter disk is compatible with various Ariete espresso machine models. To ensure proper fit and function, verify your machine's model number against the list of compatible products. The product data for your appliance can typically be found on the identification plate, usually located on the underside of the household appliance.

3. INSTALLATION

1. **Preparation:** Ensure your espresso machine is turned off and unplugged from the power outlet. Allow the machine to cool down if it has recently been in use.
2. **Locate Filter Holder:** Identify the filter holder (portafilter) of your espresso machine.
3. **Remove Existing Filter (if any):** If a disposable or old filter is present, carefully remove it from the filter holder. Dispose of any used filters properly.
4. **Insert Permanent Filter Disk:** Place the Ariete permanent steel filter disk into the filter holder. Ensure it sits flush and securely within the designated slot. The disk should not be loose or uneven.
5. **Secure:** Once the filter disk is correctly seated, you can proceed to add your ground coffee as per your espresso machine's standard operating instructions.

4. USAGE

After installing the permanent steel filter disk, operate your espresso machine as you normally would. The filter disk functions to properly filter the coffee grounds during the brewing process. Ensure that the filter disk is clean before each use to maintain optimal coffee flavor and machine performance.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning of the permanent steel filter disk is essential for hygiene and to ensure the longevity and performance of your espresso machine.

1. **After Each Use:** After brewing, remove the filter holder from the machine. Discard the used coffee grounds. Rinse the filter disk thoroughly under warm running water to remove any remaining coffee particles.
2. **Deep Cleaning (Weekly/Bi-weekly):** For a more thorough clean, you can soak the filter disk in a solution of warm water and a mild, food-safe detergent. Use a soft brush to gently scrub away any stubborn coffee oils or residue.
3. **Rinsing:** Rinse the filter disk meticulously to ensure no detergent residue remains.
4. **Drying:** Allow the filter disk to air dry completely before re-inserting it into the machine or storing it.

Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as these can damage the steel surface of the filter disk.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Filter Disk Does Not Fit:**

Action: Double-check the compatibility section and your espresso machine's model number. Ensure the filter disk is correctly oriented and seated. If it still does not fit, it may not be compatible with your specific machine. Contact customer support.

- **Poor Coffee Flow:**

Action: This often indicates a clogged filter. Remove and thoroughly clean the filter disk as described in the Maintenance section. Ensure all perforations are clear of coffee grounds or residue.

- **Coffee Grounds in Brewed Coffee:**

Action: Ensure the filter disk is correctly seated and not damaged. Also, check the fineness of your coffee grind; if it's too fine, some particles might pass through.
