INTRODUCTION

This document provides essential instructions for the proper use, installation, and maintenance of your AIR-O-SWISS Ultrasonic Humidifier 7133/7135 replacement water tank. This tank is designed specifically for AIR-O-SWISS humidifier models 7133 and 7135. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your humidifier.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This section details the steps for installing your new replacement water tank onto your AIR-O-SWISS Ultrasonic Humidifier base.

Unpacking the Water Tank

Carefully remove the water tank from its packaging. Inspect the tank for any visible damage. If damage is present, do not use the tank and contact customer support.

Filling the Water Tank

1. Remove the water tank from the humidifier base, if it is currently attached.
2. Turn the water tank upside down. Locate and unscrew the tank cap.
3. Fill the tank with clean, cool tap water. Avoid using hot water or adding any additives (e.g., essential oils, medication) directly into the water tank, as this may damage the humidifier.
4. Securely screw the tank cap back into place. Ensure it is tightened to prevent leaks.

Placing the Water Tank on the Base

1. Ensure the humidifier base is clean and free of debris.

2. Carefully place the filled water tank onto the humidifier base. The tank should sit firmly and level on the base.
3. Once placed, water will begin to flow from the tank into the base reservoir. This is a normal process.

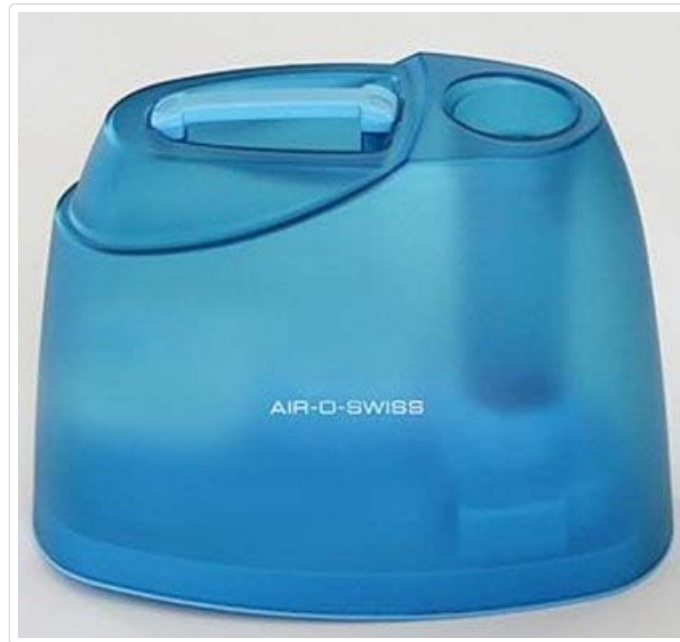

OPERATING THE HUMIDIFIER WITH THE NEW TANK

Once the water tank is properly installed and filled, you can operate your AIR-O-SWISS humidifier according to its original operating instructions. The replacement tank functions identically to the original tank.

- Ensure the humidifier is plugged into a suitable power outlet.
- Turn on the humidifier using its power control.
- Adjust settings (e.g., mist output, humidity level) as desired, referring to your humidifier's main instruction manual.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning of the water tank is crucial for maintaining hygiene and ensuring the efficient operation of your humidifier. Neglecting cleaning can lead to mineral buildup and bacterial growth.

Daily Maintenance

- Empty any remaining water from the tank and base daily.
- Rinse the water tank with fresh water.
- Refill with clean, cool tap water.

Weekly Cleaning

1. Unplug the humidifier and remove the water tank.
2. Unscrew the tank cap.

3. Fill the tank with a solution of 2 tablespoons of white vinegar and 1 gallon of water.
4. Let the solution stand in the tank for 20-30 minutes to loosen mineral deposits.
5. Use a soft brush or cloth to gently scrub the inside of the tank.
6. Rinse the tank thoroughly with clean water until the vinegar smell is gone.
7. Allow the tank to air dry completely before reassembling or storing.

Important:

- Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or metal brushes, as these can damage the tank.
- Ensure all parts are dry before storing to prevent mold and mildew growth.

TROUBLESHOOTING (WATER TANK RELATED)

If you encounter issues with your humidifier after installing the new water tank, consider the following common problems and solutions:

No Mist or Low Mist Output

- **Tank not seated correctly:** Remove the tank and reposition it firmly on the base. Ensure there are no gaps.
- **Tank cap not tightened:** Unscrew, then re-tighten the tank cap securely.
- **Insufficient water:** Check the water level in the tank and refill if necessary.

Water Leakage

- **Tank cap loose:** Ensure the tank cap is tightly screwed on.
- **Tank not seated correctly:** Remove and re-seat the tank on the base, ensuring a proper fit.
- **Damage to tank or cap:** Inspect the tank and cap for cracks or damage. If damaged, replacement may be necessary.
