1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the Redragon M705 Wired Gaming Mouse. It covers setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device. The Redragon M705 is designed for high-performance gaming, featuring an ergonomic design and customizable functions.

3. SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your Redragon M705 gaming mouse:

1. **Connect the Mouse:** Locate an available USB port on your computer. Insert the USB connector of the Redragon M705 mouse into the USB port.
2. **Driver Installation:** The mouse is typically plug-and-play. Your operating system (Windows, Linux) should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This process may take a few moments.
3. **Verification:** Once drivers are installed, the mouse's LED lighting should illuminate, and the cursor should respond to movement.
4. **Optional Software:** For advanced customization, including button remapping, DPI settings, and lighting effects, download the official Redragon software from the manufacturer's website.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Redragon M705 features 6 programmable buttons and adjustable DPI settings for precise control.

4.1 Basic Functions

- **Left Click:** Primary action button.
- **Right Click:** Secondary action button, typically for context menus.
- **Scroll Wheel:** Scrolls content up or down. Can also be pressed for a middle-click function.
- **Forward/Backward Buttons:** Located on the side, typically used for navigation in web browsers or file explorers.
- **DPI Button:** Cycles through preset DPI (Dots Per Inch) sensitivity levels.

4.2 DPI Adjustment

Press the dedicated DPI button (usually located below the scroll wheel) to cycle through different sensitivity levels. Each press will change the DPI, often indicated by a change in the mouse's LED color or pattern. Refer to the software for specific DPI values and corresponding indicators.

5. CUSTOMIZATION

To unlock the full potential of your Redragon M705 mouse, download and install the official Redragon customization software. This software allows you to:

- **Remap Buttons:** Assign custom functions or macros to any of the 6 buttons.
- **Adjust DPI Settings:** Fine-tune DPI levels and create multiple profiles for different applications or games.
- **Manage Lighting:** Customize the RGB lighting effects, colors, and brightness.
- **Create Profiles:** Save different configurations for various games or tasks, and switch between them easily.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your gaming mouse.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the mouse. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Sensor Cleaning:** Occasionally, use a cotton swab or compressed air to clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse to prevent tracking issues.
- **Cable Care:** Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the USB cable to prevent internal damage.
- **Storage:** Store the mouse in a clean, dry environment when not in use.

Problem	Solution
Mouse not detected / No response	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to a working USB port. • Try a different USB port on your computer. • Restart your computer. • Test the mouse on another computer to rule out a hardware issue.
Erratic cursor movement / Poor tracking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse. • Ensure you are using the mouse on a clean, non-reflective, and uniform surface (e.g., a mouse pad). • Check for any software conflicts or outdated drivers.
Buttons not responding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check if the buttons have been remapped in the Redragon software. • Ensure the software is running correctly if custom profiles are in use. • Restart your computer.
LED lights not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Verify the mouse is properly connected and powered. • Check lighting settings within the Redragon customization software.
