# INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Sharp RRMCG1236AJSA Original Replacement Remote Control. This remote is designed for use with compatible Sharp Video Cassette Recorders (VCRs).

Please read this manual thoroughly before using the remote control to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

# **SETUP**

# **Battery Installation**

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
- 2. Slide the battery compartment cover downwards or outwards to open it.
- 3. Insert two (2) AA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align with the markings inside the compartment.
- 4. Replace the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into position until it clicks securely.

**Note:** Always replace both batteries at the same time. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries. Remove batteries if the remote will not be used for an extended period.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sharp RRMCG1236AJSA remote control features a variety of buttons for controlling your VCR and television functions. Below is a guide to the primary functions.

# **Power and Input Selection**

- POWER: Turns the VCR power on or off.
- TV POWER: Turns the television power on or off.
- TV/VIDEO: Switches the television input between TV and Video modes.

#### **Channel and Volume Control**

- CH ▲/▼: Changes the channel up or down.
- **VOL** ▲/▼: Adjusts the volume up or down.
- MUTE: Mutes or unmutes the audio.

### **VCR Playback Controls**

- PLAY (►): Starts tape playback.
- STOP (E): Stops tape playback or recording.
- PAUSE/STILL (II): Pauses playback or recording; displays a still frame.
- **REW** ( ◄ ◄): Rewinds the tape.
- **FF** (► ►): Fast forwards the tape.
- REC (•): Initiates recording. Press once to arm, press again to start.
- EJECT (▲ EJECT): Ejects the video cassette.

# **Menu and Navigation**

- MENU: Displays the VCR's on-screen menu.
- ON SCREEN: Activates or deactivates on-screen display.
- Directional Arrows (▲ ▼ ◄ ►): Navigates through menu options.
- SET: Confirms a selection in the menu.
- CANCEL: Exits a menu or cancels an operation.

#### **Additional Functions**

- Number Pad (0-9): Direct channel selection or inputting numbers for programming.
- PROG: Used for VCR programming functions.
- ZERO BACK: Returns the tape counter to zero.
- SKIP SEARCH: Skips forward during playback.
- REPLAY: Rewinds briefly during playback.
- AM/FM: (If applicable to your VCR model) Switches between AM and FM radio bands.
- INPUT: Selects input source.
- SP/LP/EP: Selects tape speed (Standard Play, Long Play, Extended Play).
- SLOW: Activates slow-motion playback.
- TV/VCR: Switches control between TV and VCR.

#### MAINTENANCE

# **Cleaning the Remote**

To clean the remote control, gently wipe its surface with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the remote's finish or internal components.

# **Battery Care**

• Replace batteries promptly when the remote's performance degrades.

- If the remote will not be used for an extended period (e.g., one month or more), remove the batteries to prevent leakage and potential damage.
- Dispose of used batteries according to local regulations.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote not responding.	Dead or incorrectly inserted batteries.	Replace batteries with new AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
Remote not responding.	Obstruction between remote and VCR/TV.	Ensure a clear line of sight between the remote's infrared emitter and the VCR/TV's sensor.
Remote only controls VCR, not TV.	Remote is in VCR mode.	Press the <b>TV/VCR</b> button to switch to TV control mode.
Buttons are sticky or unresponsive.	Dirt or debris under buttons.	Clean the remote surface as described in the Maintenance section.
