PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The National Tree Company Pre-Lit Artificial Slim Christmas Tree is designed to bring festive cheer with its lifelike appearance and convenient features. This 7-foot tall North Valley Spruce model features a slim profile, making it ideal for spaces with limited width.

- **Lifelike Design:** Hundreds of individually crafted branch tips create full-bodied, realistic branches.
- **Pre-Lit Convenience:** Strung with 500 clear (white) UL lights that remain lit even if a bulb goes out.
- **Easy Assembly:** Hinged branches drop down for simple setup and fold back for easy storage.
- **Durable Construction:** Built with sturdy, high-quality, hypo-allergenic, and fire-resistant materials, including a durable metal stand.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for quick and easy assembly of your Christmas tree.

1. Assemble the Stand

Unfold the metal stand and ensure it is stable on a flat surface. Insert the bottom section of the tree into the stand and secure it with the provided screw.

2. Connect Tree Sections

Your tree comes in multiple sections. Carefully stack each section, aligning the poles. The hinged branches will automatically fall into place.

3. Shape the Branches

For a full and realistic appearance, set aside 45-60 minutes to properly shape the tree. Gently peel back the branches and pull the tips apart, fanning them out to fill any gaps. This process enhances the tree's natural look.

4. Connect the Lights

The tree is pre-strung with 500 clear (white) lights. Connect the light strands between each section. Ensure all connections are secure before plugging the tree into a power outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled, operating your pre-lit Christmas tree is simple.

1. **Power On:** Plug the tree's power cord into a standard electrical outlet.
2. **Light Functionality:** The tree features UL-certified lights designed to remain lit even if a single bulb burns out, provided the bulb lens is not cracked or broken.
3. **Decoration:** After confirming all lights are working, you can begin decorating your tree with ornaments and garlands. The full-bodied branches provide ample space for various decorations.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure your Christmas tree remains beautiful for many seasons.

- **Cleaning:** Dust the branches periodically with a soft cloth or duster. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Needle Care:** The tree features hypo-allergenic and fire-resistant needles, ensuring safety and durability.
- **Storage:** After the holiday season, carefully remove all ornaments and decorations. Fold the hinged branches upwards and disassemble the tree sections. Store the tree in its original box or a dedicated tree storage bag in a cool, dry place to protect it from dust and damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Christmas tree, refer to the following common solutions.

- **Lights Not Working:**
 - Check all power connections to ensure they are securely plugged in.
 - Verify that the power outlet is functional.
 - While lights are designed to stay lit if one bulb goes out, check for any severely damaged or missing bulbs that might affect a larger section. Replace as needed with bulbs of the same type and wattage.
- **Tree Stability:**
 - Ensure the metal stand is fully extended and the securing screw is tightened.
 - Place the tree on a flat, even surface.
- **Branch Fullness:**
 - If branches appear sparse, dedicate additional time to fluffing and shaping each individual tip to maximize fullness.
