# De'Longhi Water Tank for Tasciugo Ariadry Multi DEX16 Dehumidifier Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your new De'Longhi replacement water tank. This water tank is specifically designed for use with De'Longhi Tasciugo Ariadry Multi DEX16 dehumidifier models. Please read these instructions carefully before using the product to ensure safe and efficient operation.

## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe the following safety precautions:

- Ensure the dehumidifier is unplugged from the power outlet before installing or removing the water tank.
- Handle the water tank with care to prevent damage. Do not drop or apply excessive force.
- Do not use the water tank for purposes other than collecting condensed water from the specified dehumidifier models.
- Keep the water tank clean to prevent mold or bacterial growth.
- Do not drink the water collected in the tank; it is not potable.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This product is an original De'Longhi replacement water tank for the Tasciugo Ariadry Multi DEX16 series of dehumidifiers. It is designed to seamlessly integrate with your existing appliance, ensuring optimal performance in collecting moisture from the air.

## 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

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Follow these steps to install the replacement water tank:

1. **Unplug the Dehumidifier:** Before beginning, ensure the dehumidifier is completely unplugged from the electrical outlet to prevent any electrical hazards.
2. **Remove Old Tank (if applicable):** If you are replacing an existing tank, carefully slide out the old water tank from its compartment in the dehumidifier. Dispose of any collected water responsibly.
3. **Inspect the New Tank:** Check the new water tank for any signs of damage from shipping. Ensure all components are intact.
4. **Insert the New Tank:** Align the new water tank with the tank compartment in the dehumidifier. Gently slide the tank into place until it clicks or sits firmly. Ensure it is fully seated to prevent leaks and allow the dehumidifier to operate correctly.
5. **Verify Installation:** Once installed, give the tank a gentle tug to confirm it is securely in position. The dehumidifier's indicator light for the water tank should not be illuminated if the tank is correctly installed and empty.
6. **Plug In the Dehumidifier:** You may now plug the dehumidifier back into the power outlet.

## 5. OPERATING THE DEHUMIDIFIER WITH THE WATER TANK

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The water tank automatically collects condensed moisture from the air during dehumidifier operation. When the tank is full, the dehumidifier will typically stop operating and illuminate a 'Tank Full' indicator light.

- **Monitoring Water Level:** The tank is often made of translucent material, allowing you to visually monitor the water level.
- **Emptying the Water Tank:** When the tank is full, carefully slide it out from the dehumidifier. Carry it to a sink or drain and empty the collected water.
- **Reinserting the Empty Tank:** After emptying, slide the clean tank back into its compartment until it is fully seated. The dehumidifier should resume operation automatically once the tank is correctly reinserted.

## 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

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Regular cleaning of the water tank is crucial for hygiene and to prevent the growth of mold, mildew, or bacteria.

- **Frequency:** Clean the water tank at least once every two weeks, or more frequently if the dehumidifier is used continuously or in a very humid environment.
- **Cleaning Procedure:**
  - a. Remove the water tank from the dehumidifier.
  - b. Empty any remaining water.
  - c. Wash the inside of the tank with warm water and a mild detergent. Use a soft brush or sponge to scrub away any residue.
  - d. Rinse the tank thoroughly with clean water to remove all soap residue.
  - e. Allow the tank to air dry completely before reinserting it into the dehumidifier, or wipe it dry with a clean cloth.
- **Do Not Use Harsh Chemicals:** Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the plastic of the tank.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues related to the water tank, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Problem                                         | Possible Cause                                         | Solution                                                                                                                              |

| Water tank not fitting correctly                | Incorrect alignment; obstruction in compartment.       | Remove tank, check for obstructions, and reinsert carefully, ensuring proper alignment.                                               |
| Water leakage from tank area                    | Tank not fully seated; damaged tank; seal issue.       | Ensure tank is fully pushed in. Inspect tank for cracks. If leakage persists, contact support.                                        |
| Dehumidifier not collecting water (tank empty)  | Tank not properly installed; dehumidifier malfunction. | Verify tank is correctly seated. If issue persists, consult your dehumidifier's main instruction manual or contact De'Longhi support. |
| 'Tank Full' indicator remains on after emptying | Tank not fully reinserted; float switch stuck.         | Ensure tank is fully seated. Gently shake the tank to free the float switch if it appears stuck.                                      |
