INTRODUCTION

The Garmin Vivoactive 3 is a versatile GPS smartwatch designed for an active lifestyle. It features built-in sports apps, contactless payment capabilities, and smart notifications to keep you connected. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device.

SETUP

1. Unboxing Your Device

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. The box should contain the Vivoactive 3 smartwatch, a charging/data cable, and documentation. Inspect all items for any damage.

2. Charging the Device

Before initial use, fully charge your Vivoactive 3. Connect the charging/data cable to the charging port on the back of the watch and plug the other end into a USB power source. A full charge typically takes a few hours.

OPERATING THE VIVOACTIVE 3

1. Interface Navigation

The Vivoactive 3 features a touchscreen display and a single side button for navigation. Swipe up or down on the

touchscreen to scroll through widgets and menus. Tap to select options. Press and hold the side button to access the controls menu, which includes options like power, lock, and Bluetooth settings.

2. Using Preloaded Sports Apps

The Vivoactive 3 comes with over 15 preloaded GPS and indoor sports apps, including yoga, running, swimming, and more. To start an activity, press the side button, select the desired activity, and follow the prompts. The watch will track your performance metrics relevant to the chosen activity.

3. Garmin Pay Contactless Payments

The Vivoactive 3 features Garmin Pay, a contactless payment solution. You can add supported cards from participating banks to your watch's wallet. To make a payment, access the Garmin Pay menu from the controls, enter your passcode, and hold your watch near a compatible payment terminal.

4. Smart Notifications

When paired with a compatible smartphone, the Vivoactive 3 can display smart notifications for calls, texts, emails, and other

app alerts. You can customize which notifications appear on your watch through the Garmin Connect app.

5. Fitness Tracking and Health Monitoring

The watch continuously monitors your fitness level with features like VO2 max estimates, fitness age, and stress tracking. It also tracks daily steps, calories burned, and sleep patterns. All data is synced to the Garmin Connect app for detailed analysis.

MAINTENANCE

1. Battery Life Optimization

To extend the battery life of your Vivoactive 3, consider the following adjustments:

- Reduce the backlight timeout.

- Reduce the backlight brightness.
- Turn off Bluetooth wireless technology when not using connected features.
- Turn off activity tracking if not needed.
- Limit the number of smartphone notifications the device displays.
- Stop broadcasting heart rate data to paired Garmin devices.
- Turn off wrist-based heart rate monitoring when not required.

2. Cleaning Your Device

Regularly clean your Vivoactive 3 to maintain its performance and appearance. Wipe the device with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the watch.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Vivoactive 3, try the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **Restart the device:** Press and hold the side button until the power options appear, then select 'Power Off'. Wait a few seconds and press the button again to turn it back on.
- **Check for software updates:** Ensure your device and the Garmin Connect app are running the latest software versions.
- **Re-pair the device:** If connectivity issues persist, try unpairing and re-pairing your watch with the Garmin Connect app.
