INTRODUCTION

The LINKChef PB-6530 Personal Blender is designed to simplify your healthy lifestyle. This powerful 300W blender with a 27,000 RPM pure copper motor and 4-blade stainless steel assembly allows for quick preparation of fruit and vegetable juices, milkshakes, smoothies, and baby food. It comes with two portable BPA-free bottles, making it convenient to enjoy your fresh preparations anywhere.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage, please read and follow these instructions carefully:

- **Do not immerse the motor base in water or any other liquid.** This can cause electric shock.
- The blades are sharp. **Handle them with extreme caution** during assembly, disassembly, and cleaning.
- Ensure the bottle is securely locked onto the motor base before operating. The blender features a safety interlock switch that prevents operation unless properly assembled.
- Do not operate the blender continuously for more than 1 minute to prevent overheating. Allow the motor to cool down between cycles.
- Keep hands and utensils out of the container while blending to prevent injury.
- Always unplug the blender from the power outlet before cleaning or when not in use.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of

experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

- Keep out of reach of children.

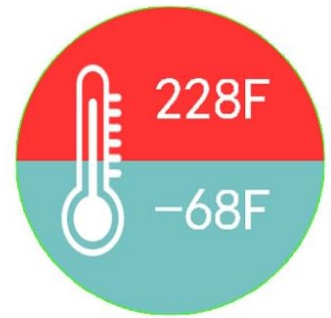
PRODUCT COMPONENTS AND FEATURES

The LINKChef PB-6530 blender comes with the following components and features:

- **Motor Base:** Contains the 300W motor and non-slip feet for stability.
- **Blade Assembly:** Features 4 durable 304-grade stainless steel blades for efficient blending.
- **Portable Bottles (x2):** 500ml capacity, made from BPA-free food-grade plastic.
- **Travel Lids (x2):** Secure, leak-proof lids for on-the-go convenience.
- **User Manual (x1):** This document.

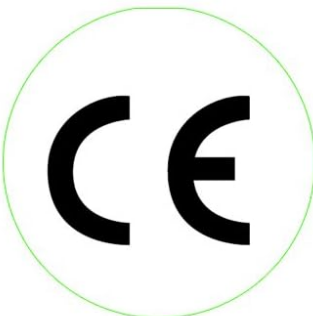

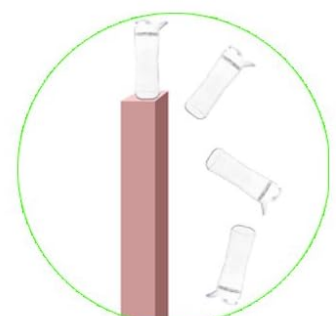

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to set up your LINKChef Personal Blender:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Before first use, wash the portable bottles, travel lids, and blade assembly with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. The motor base should only be wiped with a damp cloth.
3. **Prepare Ingredients:** Cut fruits and vegetables into small pieces (approximately 1-2 inches) to ensure smooth blending. Do not overfill the bottle; ensure ingredients do not exceed the MAX fill line.
4. **Assemble:**
 - Place your prepared ingredients into one of the portable bottles. Add liquid (water, milk, juice) as desired.
 - Screw the blade assembly firmly onto the open end of the bottle, ensuring a tight seal.
 - Invert the bottle so the blade assembly faces downwards, and align it with the motor base.

- Twist the bottle clockwise onto the motor base until it locks securely into place. You will feel a click when it is properly engaged.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled, operating your blender is straightforward:

1. **Plug In:** Connect the power cord to a standard electrical outlet.
2. **Start Blending:** Press down on the bottle to activate the blending cycle. The motor will run as long as you apply downward pressure.
3. **Pulse Function:** For thicker mixtures or to chop ingredients, press down and release the bottle repeatedly in short bursts.
4. **Stop Blending:** Release the downward pressure on the bottle. The motor will stop.

5. **Remove Bottle:** Twist the bottle counter-clockwise to unlock it from the motor base, then lift it off.
6. **Enjoy:** Unscrew the blade assembly from the bottle and replace it with a travel lid for immediate consumption or storage.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and hygiene of your blender:

- **Motor Base:** Unplug the unit. Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth. Do not submerge it in water.
- **Bottles and Lids:** The portable bottles and travel lids are dishwasher safe (top rack recommended) or can be washed by hand with warm, soapy water.
- **Blade Assembly:** Carefully rinse the blade assembly under running water immediately after use to prevent food from drying on the blades. Use a brush if necessary to remove stubborn residue. Exercise extreme caution due to sharp blades.
- **Storage:** Store the blender in a clean, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your blender, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Blender does not turn on. | Not plugged in; bottle not securely locked; motor overheated. | Ensure power cord is firmly plugged in. Twist bottle clockwise until it clicks into place. Unplug and let motor cool for 15-20 minutes if it has been running continuously. |
| Ingredients are not blending smoothly. | Too little liquid; too many ingredients; ingredients are too large. | Add more liquid. Reduce the amount of ingredients. Cut ingredients into smaller pieces. Use the pulse function. |
| Leakage from the bottle. | Blade assembly not tightened properly; bottle overfilled. | Ensure the blade assembly is screwed on tightly to the bottle. Do not fill ingredients past the MAX fill line. |
| Burning smell or smoke. | Motor overload; foreign object in blades. | Immediately unplug the blender. Reduce ingredients and liquid. Check for any obstructions around the blades. If the issue persists, discontinue use and contact customer support. |
