Mainstays 14-Quart Roaster Oven Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your Mainstays 14-Quart Roaster Oven. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the main unit in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any

control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.

- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- **CAUTION: HOT SURFACE.** The exterior surfaces of the roaster oven become hot during operation. Use oven mitts or pot holders when handling.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Mainstays 14-Quart Roaster Oven is designed for roasting, baking, slow cooking, and serving. It features a large capacity suitable for up to a 20-pound turkey, an adjustable temperature control, and a removable roasting rack.

Components:

- Roaster Base Unit
- Removable Roasting Pan
- High-Dome Lid
- Removable Roasting Rack
- Temperature Control Knob

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and inspect the roaster oven for any damage.

Retain packaging for future storage if desired.

2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the removable roasting pan and roasting rack in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the roaster base unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the base unit in water.
3. **Placement:** Place the roaster oven on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls and other appliances, ensuring adequate ventilation. Ensure the power cord is not obstructed or near hot surfaces.
4. **Assembly:** Insert the clean roasting pan into the roaster base unit. Place the roasting rack inside the roasting pan.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

General Operation:

1. **Prepare Food:** Place your food item (e.g., turkey, roast) on the removable roasting rack within the roasting pan.
2. **Cover:** Place the high-dome lid securely on the roaster oven.
3. **Plug In:** Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.
4. **Set Temperature:** Turn the temperature control knob to the desired setting. The temperature range is approximately 150°F to 450°F (65°C to 232°C).
5. **Preheating:** Allow the roaster oven to preheat for 15-20 minutes before placing food inside for optimal results, especially for roasting and baking.
6. **Cooking:** Monitor cooking progress. Cooking times may vary based on food type and quantity. Refer to a reliable recipe or food thermometer for doneness.
7. **Serving:** Use oven mitts to carefully remove the lid. The removable roasting pan can be lifted out for serving, or food can be served directly from the pan.
8. **Turn Off:** Once cooking is complete, turn the temperature control knob to the "OFF" position and unplug the unit from the wall outlet.

Temperature Control Settings:

The adjustable temperature control allows for various cooking methods:

- **Warm (Min - 150°F):** Ideal for keeping cooked food warm before serving.
- **Slow Cook (150°F - 250°F):** Suitable for slow cooking recipes.
- **Bake/Roast (250°F - 450°F):** For baking casseroles, roasting meats, and other dishes requiring higher temperatures.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the roaster oven and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Removable Parts:** The roasting pan and roasting rack are dishwasher safe or can be washed by hand in warm, soapy water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that may damage the non-stick surface.
3. **Lid:** Wash the high-dome lid in warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly. Dry completely.
4. **Base Unit:** Wipe the exterior and interior of the roaster base unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the base unit in water or any other liquid. Ensure no water enters the electrical components.
5. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing. Store the roaster oven in a cool, dry place. The lid can be inverted and placed inside the roasting pan for compact storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Roaster does not heat.	Not plugged in; power outlet not working; temperature knob set to OFF.	Ensure unit is securely plugged into a working outlet. Turn temperature knob to desired setting.
Food cooks too slowly or unevenly.	Temperature setting too low; lid not sealed properly; too much food.	Increase temperature setting. Ensure lid is seated correctly. Reduce food quantity or extend cooking time.
Exterior surfaces are very hot.	Normal operation.	This is normal. Always use oven mitts or pot holders when handling the hot roaster oven.
Smoke or unusual odor during first use.	Protective coating burning off.	This is normal for first use. Ensure good ventilation. If smoke persists, unplug and contact customer support.
