## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Polder Stainless Steel Toilet Brush Caddy. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your new toilet brush and caddy system. ## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 2 x Polder Stainless Steel Toilet Brush Caddies
- 2 x Toilet Brushes with Stainless Steel Handles
- 2 x Replacement Brush Heads

### 3. SETUP

The Polder Toilet Brush Caddy is designed for immediate use with minimal assembly required. The brush heads are typically pre-attached to the handles. If not, follow these steps:

1. Unpack all components from the packaging.
2. To attach a brush head, align the threaded end of the brush head with the threaded base of the stainless steel handle.
3. Twist the brush head clockwise until it is securely fastened. Do not overtighten.
4. Place the assembled toilet brush into the caddy. The brush should hang suspended within the caddy, allowing for air circulation and drip drying.
5. Position the caddy in a convenient location near your toilet. The caddy features rubber feet on the bottom for stability and to prevent slipping.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To use the Polder Stainless Steel Toilet Brush Caddy for cleaning:

1. Lift the toilet brush from its caddy. The caddy is designed to remain stable when the brush is removed.
2. Apply your preferred toilet bowl cleaner to the inside of the toilet bowl.
3. Use the brush to scrub all surfaces of the toilet bowl, including under the rim and the water line. The brush bristles are designed to effectively clean various areas.
4. Once cleaning is complete, rinse the brush by flushing the toilet and holding the brush in the swirling water.
5. Return the clean brush to its caddy. The brush will hang suspended, allowing excess water to drip into the caddy's base and air dry.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your Polder Toilet Brush Caddy:

- **Caddy Cleaning:** Periodically empty any accumulated water from the caddy's base. Clean the inside of the caddy with a disinfectant cleaner and rinse thoroughly. Allow it to air dry before replacing the brush.
- **Brush Head Cleaning:** After each use, ensure the brush head is rinsed thoroughly. For deeper cleaning, you can soak the brush head in a disinfectant solution.
- **Storage:** Always store the brush in its caddy to allow for proper drying and to keep the brush discreetly out of sight.

## 6. REPLACING BRUSH HEADS

To replace a worn brush head with a new one:

1. Hold the stainless steel handle firmly.
2. Twist the old brush head counter-clockwise to unscrew it from the handle.
3. Dispose of the old brush head responsibly.
4. Take a new replacement brush head and align its threaded end with the handle.
5. Twist the new brush head clockwise until it is securely attached.
