- Adjustable Shelf:** The interior cabinet includes one adjustable shelf, offering two tiers of storage space that can be customized based on item size.

Exercise caution when moving the cart to avoid injury from the side handle or accidental collisions. Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened during assembly and periodically check for any loosening to maintain structural integrity.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Using the Drawers and Cabinet:

- To open a drawer, gently pull the handle. To close, push until it is fully seated.
- To open the cabinet doors, pull the handles. To close, push firmly until the magnetic catches engage.
- The internal shelf can be adjusted to different heights by removing the shelf pins, repositioning the shelf, and reinserting the pins into the desired holes.

### Moving and Securing the Cart:

- To move the cart, ensure all caster locks are disengaged. Use the side handle to push or pull the cart to your desired location.
- To secure the cart in place, engage the locks on the two front casters by pressing down on the lever. This will prevent the cart from rolling.

## Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the cart surfaces with a dry cloth to remove dust and spills. For stubborn marks, use a slightly damp cloth with mild soap, then dry immediately. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Wood Countertop Care:** The rubber wood countertop should be regularly cleaned and can be treated with food-safe mineral oil to maintain its appearance and prevent drying.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain stability.
- **Casters:** Keep casters free of debris to ensure smooth rolling. Lubricate if necessary.

## Troubleshooting

- **Wobbly Cart:** Ensure all assembly screws are tightened. Check that the casters are securely attached and that the cart is on a level surface.
- **Drawers Not Sliding Smoothly:** Verify that the drawer slides are correctly installed and aligned. Check for any obstructions in the tracks. Ensure screws holding the slides are not overtightened, which can cause binding.

- **Cabinet Doors Not Closing Properly:** Check the alignment of the hinges and magnetic catches. Adjust hinges if necessary to ensure the doors close flush with the frame.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts were missing upon delivery, refer to the parts list in your manual and contact Giantex customer support for replacements.
