1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Lock'er Down Console Safe, model LD2045. Designed to secure personal items within your vehicle's console, this safe offers robust protection and convenient access. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure proper function and longevity of your product.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lock'er Down Console Safe is constructed from solid domestic 12-gauge cold-rolled steel, featuring a durable black powder coat finish and a spring-assisted door hinge. It is equipped with a 4-digit combination lock for secure access.

3. COMPATIBILITY

This console safe is compatible with the following Ford vehicle models equipped with a full floor console:

- 2015-2020 Ford F150 (including Raptor models)
- 2017-2023 Ford Super Duty
- 2018-2022 Ford Expedition

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Lock'er Down Console Safe is designed for easy installation. While specific steps may vary slightly by vehicle model, the general process involves securing the safe within the existing console structure.

Required Tools:

- 1/2 inch open-end wrench
- Phillips head screwdriver (or drill/driver with Phillips bit)

5. OPERATING THE COMBINATION LOCK

Your Lock'er Down Console Safe is equipped with a 4-digit combination lock for secure access to your valuables.

Setting Your Combination:

Opening the Safe:

1. Rotate the dials to align your 4-digit combination with the indicator marks.
2. Once the correct combination is entered, the lock mechanism will disengage.
3. Lift the safe door using the spring-assisted hinge.

Closing and Locking the Safe:

1. Lower the safe door until it is fully closed.
2. Scramble the combination dials to secure the lock.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the continued performance and appearance of your Lock'er Down Console Safe, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the powder coat finish.
- **Lock Mechanism:** Periodically check the combination lock for smooth operation. If the dials become stiff, a small amount of graphite lubricant can be applied. Do not use oil-based lubricants.
- **Hinges:** The spring-assisted hinge is designed for durability. If any squeaking occurs, a light application of silicone spray lubricant can be used.
- **Fasteners:** Occasionally check all mounting fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Lock'er Down Console Safe, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

Safe Door Will Not Open:

- **Incorrect Combination:** Double-check that the correct 4-digit combination is entered and aligned precisely with the indicator marks.
- **Dials Not Fully Engaged:** Ensure each dial is fully rotated to its number and not stuck between digits.
- **Obstruction:** Check for any items inside the console that might be obstructing the door mechanism.

Safe Door Is Loose or Rattles:

- **Loose Mounting:** Inspect the installation fasteners. If they are loose, carefully retighten them.
- **Hinge Issue:** Examine the spring-assisted hinge for any signs of damage or misalignment.




Image 8.1: Dimensional view of the console safe, indicating key measurements.
