# Sonos One User Manual

Voice Controlled Smart Speaker with Amazon Alexa Built-in

## INTRODUCTION

The Sonos One is a powerful smart speaker designed to deliver rich, room-filling sound while integrating seamlessly with Amazon Alexa for hands-free voice control. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Sonos One speaker.

With the Sonos One, you can use your voice to play music, set alarms, get news updates, manage smart home devices, and access a wide range of Alexa skills. Its versatile design allows for placement in various rooms, and it can connect wirelessly with other Sonos speakers to create a multi-room audio experience.

## WHAT'S IN THE Box

- Sonos One Speaker
- AC Power Cord
- Ethernet Cable
- Quickstart Guide

## SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Sonos One speaker:

- 1. Place Your Sonos One:** Choose a location for your speaker. For optimal sound, place it on a flat, stable surface away from walls or corners that might muffle the sound. Ensure it's within reach of a power outlet and your Wi-Fi signal.
- 2. Connect Power:** Plug the AC power cord into the Sonos One and then into a wall outlet. The status light on the speaker will flash white when it's ready to be set up.
- 3. Download the Sonos App:** Download the Sonos app on your smartphone or tablet from the App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store (Android).
- 4. Open the Sonos App:** Open the app and follow the on-screen instructions to set up your new Sonos system or add the Sonos One to an existing system. The app will guide you through connecting to your Wi-Fi network.
- 5. Add Amazon Alexa:** Once your Sonos One is connected to your Wi-Fi, the Sonos app will prompt you to add Amazon Alexa. You will need to sign in with your Amazon account and enable the Sonos skill in the Alexa app.




Figure 2: The Sonos One integrates seamlessly into home environments, providing smart audio capabilities.

## OPERATING YOUR SONOS ONE

The Sonos One offers multiple ways to control your music and smart home:

### Voice Control with Amazon Alexa

Once Alexa is enabled, simply say "Alexa" followed by your command. The Sonos One has a built-in microphone array to pick up your voice commands from across the room.

- **Play Music:** "Alexa, play [song name] by [artist] on Spotify."
- **Adjust Volume:** "Alexa, turn up the volume." or "Alexa, set volume to 5."
- **Pause/Resume:** "Alexa, pause." or "Alexa, resume."
- **Skip Track:** "Alexa, next song."
- **Information:** "Alexa, what's the weather?" or "Alexa, tell me a joke."

## Touch Controls

The top surface of your Sonos One features touch-sensitive controls:

- **Play/Pause:** Tap the Play/Pause button.
- **Volume Up/Down:** Tap the + or - buttons.
- **Skip Track:** Swipe right across the touch controls.
- **Previous Track:** Swipe left across the touch controls.
- **Microphone On/Off:** Tap the microphone icon to enable or disable voice control. When the microphone is off, the LED indicator will be off.

## Sonos App Control

The Sonos app provides comprehensive control over your speaker and music system:

- Browse and play music from various streaming services.

- Group or ungroup speakers for multi-room audio.
- Adjust EQ settings (bass, treble, loudness).
- Set up alarms and sleep timers.
- Access system settings and updates.

## MAINTENANCE

To keep your Sonos One in optimal condition:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker. Do not use cleaning sprays or chemicals directly on the speaker.
- **Placement:** Avoid placing the speaker in direct sunlight, near heat sources, or in excessively humid environments.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure proper airflow around the speaker. Do not block any vents.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Sonos One, try the following solutions:

Problem	Solution
<b>Sonos One not appearing in app</b>	<p>Ensure the power cord is securely plugged in and the status light is flashing white or solid white.</p> <p>Restart your Wi-Fi router.</p> <p>Move the speaker closer to your router.</p> <p>If using an Ethernet cable, ensure it's securely connected to both the speaker and your router.</p>
<b>Alexa not responding</b>	<p>Check if the microphone is enabled (LED indicator on the top panel should be lit).</p> <p>Ensure your Sonos One is connected to the internet.</p> <p>Verify your Amazon account is linked correctly in the Sonos app and Alexa app.</p> <p>Try restarting the Sonos One by unplugging it for 10 seconds and plugging it back in.</p>
<b>No sound or distorted sound</b>	<p>Check the volume level in the Sonos app or using the touch controls.</p> <p>Ensure the correct music source is selected.</p> <p>If playing from a streaming service, check your internet connection.</p> <p>Try playing different audio content.</p>


