## Oulm 3595 Men's Analog Watch Instruction Manual

### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Oulm 3595 Men's Analog Watch features a unique design with three independent movements and three functional sub-dials, allowing for the display of multiple time zones. It is equipped with a Japanese quartz movement for accurate timekeeping and a durable organic crystal for maximum scratch resistance. The watch is designed with a comfortable coffee-colored leather strap, providing a classic and practical wear experience.

## SETUP AND INITIAL USE

---

Before wearing your Oulm 3595 watch, please follow these steps for initial setup.

### 1. Setting the Time

The Oulm 3595 watch features three independent movements, each controlled by its own crown. Identify the crowns corresponding to each sub-dial.

- Main Dial (Center):** Pull out the crown located on the right side of the watch case to the first position. Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the desired time. Once set, push the crown back in to secure the time.
- Upper Left Sub-dial:** This sub-dial typically displays a second time zone. Pull out its dedicated crown (usually on the upper left side of the case) and rotate to set the time. Push the crown back in when finished.

3. **Lower Left Sub-dial:** Similar to the upper left, this sub-dial can be used for a third time zone. Pull out its dedicated crown (usually on the lower left side of the case) and rotate to set the time. Push the crown back in when finished.

## 2. Adjusting the Strap

The watch comes with a comfortable leather strap with a buckle closure. To adjust the fit:

- Insert the pin of the buckle into one of the holes on the strap that provides a snug yet comfortable fit around your wrist.
- Ensure the watch is not too tight, which could restrict circulation, nor too loose, which could cause it to slide excessively.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The Oulm 3595 watch is designed for straightforward operation once the time is set.

- **Time Reading:** Read the time from the main central dial for your primary time zone. The two smaller sub-dials can be used to track additional time zones as needed.
- **Daily Wear:** This watch is suitable for daily wear and casual occasions. Its robust design is intended for general use.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper care will extend the life and maintain the appearance of your Oulm 3595 watch.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth. For the leather strap, use a slightly damp cloth if necessary, and allow it to air dry completely. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Water Resistance:** This watch is not specified as water-resistant. Avoid exposure to water, including showering, swimming, or heavy rain, to prevent damage to the internal components.
- **Temperature:** Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperatures, both hot and cold, as this can affect the accuracy of the movement and the integrity of the materials.
- **Battery Replacement:** The watch uses 3 Lithium Metal batteries. When the watch stops keeping accurate time or stops completely, it is likely time to replace the batteries. It is recommended to have battery replacement performed by a qualified watch technician to avoid damaging the watch.
- **Strap Care:** Leather straps can show wear over time. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight or moisture, which can cause the leather to crack or fade.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Oulm 3595 watch, consider the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch stops or loses time	Low battery; Crown not fully pushed in.	Replace batteries (professional service recommended); Ensure all crowns are fully pushed in after setting time.
Sub-dial not working	Dedicated battery for that movement is low; Crown not fully pushed in.	Replace specific sub-dial battery; Ensure its crown is fully pushed in.
Strap discoloration or wear	Normal wear and tear; Exposure to sweat or moisture.	Clean regularly; Avoid prolonged exposure to moisture; Consider replacing the strap if heavily worn.
Watch feels loose on wrist	Strap not adjusted correctly.	Adjust the buckle to a tighter hole on the strap.
